## CATALOGUE OF THE NATIONAL METEORITE COLLECTION OF CANADA REVISED TO DECEMBER 31, 1979

### INTRODUCTION

The National Meteorite Collection was initiated by the Geological Survey of Canada in 1855 with the acquisition of MADOC, Ontario, the first meteorite to be found in Canada. From 1855 to 1914 a small number of new Canadian finds were added. Status as an international collection was gained in 1914 under the curatorship of R.A.A. Johnston with the purchase of the original Foote Meteorite Collection from the Foote Mineral Company of Philadelphia. The Foote collection included representative specimens of 212 meteorites from worldwide finds. A period of slow growth was experienced until 1958 when K.R. Dawson was appointed curator and began an inventory of the collection, most of which had been in storage for many years.

The first published catalogue of the National Meteorite Collection of Canada was by Dawson (1963). It listed 249 distinct meteorites and included 21 of the 26 meteorites known to have been found in Canada. The catalogue was revised by Douglas (1971) who noted that the collection had increased to 292 distinct meteorites. The number of known Canadian finds had risen to 40 by 1971 and 29 of these were included in the National Collection.

The present revised catalogue lists in alphabetical order the 368 distinct meteorites that are now represented in the collection, and includes geographical location, date of fall or recovery, classification, and catalogue numbers, form and mass of all specimens. The names of meteorites found in Canada are underlined. Hey (1966) and Hutchison et al. (1977) are acknowledged as references for names, dates and locations. Classifications have been taken from: Hey (1966) for achondrites and stony-irons; Van Schmus and Wood (1966) and Motylewski (1978) for chondrites; and Buchwald (1975) for irons. An alphabetical list of the 46 meteorites known to have been recovered in Canada up to December 31, 1979 is appended; those meteorites which are represented in the National Meteorite Collection are distinguished in the listing by capital letters.

The National Meteorite Collection of Canada continues to grow by acquisition of specimens through donation, purchase and exchange. The collection is a valuable scientific resource and specimens are made available whenever possible to qualified investigators for research purposes. ### INTRODUCTION

La Collection nationale de météorites voit le jour en 1855, lorsque la Commission géologique du Canada fait l'acquisition du météorite MADOC (Ontario), le premier à être trouvé au Canada. De 1855 à 1914, un petit nombre de météorites nouveaux trouvés au Canada viennent s'y ajouter. En 1914, la collection prend, sous l'impulsion de M. R.A.A. Johnston, son conservateur, une importance internationale, grâce à l'achat de la collection originale Foote de la Foote Mineral Company de Philadelphie (É.-U.), qui comprenait des spécimens de 212 météorites trouvés un peu partout dans le monde. Vient alors une période de croissance ralentie qui prend fin avec la nomination de M. K.R. Dawson au poste de conservateur en 1958. Ce dernier entreprend de faire l'inventaire de la collection, dont la plupart des composantes étaient en entreposage depuis un bon nombre d'années.

En 1963, M. Dawson publie le premier catalogue de la Collection nationale de météorites du Canada. Cet ouvrage donne la liste de 249 météorites distincts et comprend 21 des 26 météorites dont la découverte au Canada était connue. Ce catalogue est révisé par Douglas (1971), qui indique que la collection comportait alors 292 météorites distincts. Le nombre de découvertes connues au Canada est de 40 en 1971; 29 des météorites en question figurent alors dans la Collection nationale.

La présente édition révisée du catalogue donne, dans l'ordre alphabétique, la liste des 368 météorites distincts qui constituent la collection et indique le lieu de découverte, la date de chute ou de découverte, la classification, le numéro de catalogue, la forme et la masse de tous les spécimens. Les noms des météorites trouvées au Canada sont soulignés. Les noms, les dates et les lieux sont tirés de Hey (1966) et Hutchison et coll. (1977). Les classifications ont été tirées de Hey (1966) pour les achondrites et les fers pierreux, de Van Schmus et Wood (1966) et Motylewski (1978) pour les chondrites et de Buchwald (1975) pour les fers. La liste alphabétique des 46 météorites trouvées au Canada jusqu'au 31 décembre 1979 est donnée en annexe; les noms des météorites qui font partie de la Collection nationale de météorites sont écrits en majuscules.

La Collection nationale de météorites du Canada continue de prendre de l'ampleur par les dons, les achats et les échanges de spécimens. Il s'agit là d'un instrument scientifique des plus utiles; dans la mesure du possible, les spécimens sont mis à la disposition de chercheurs qualifiés. La participation active à la croissance et à l'utilisation de la Collection est encouragée. Prière d'adresser toute demande de renseignements au:
