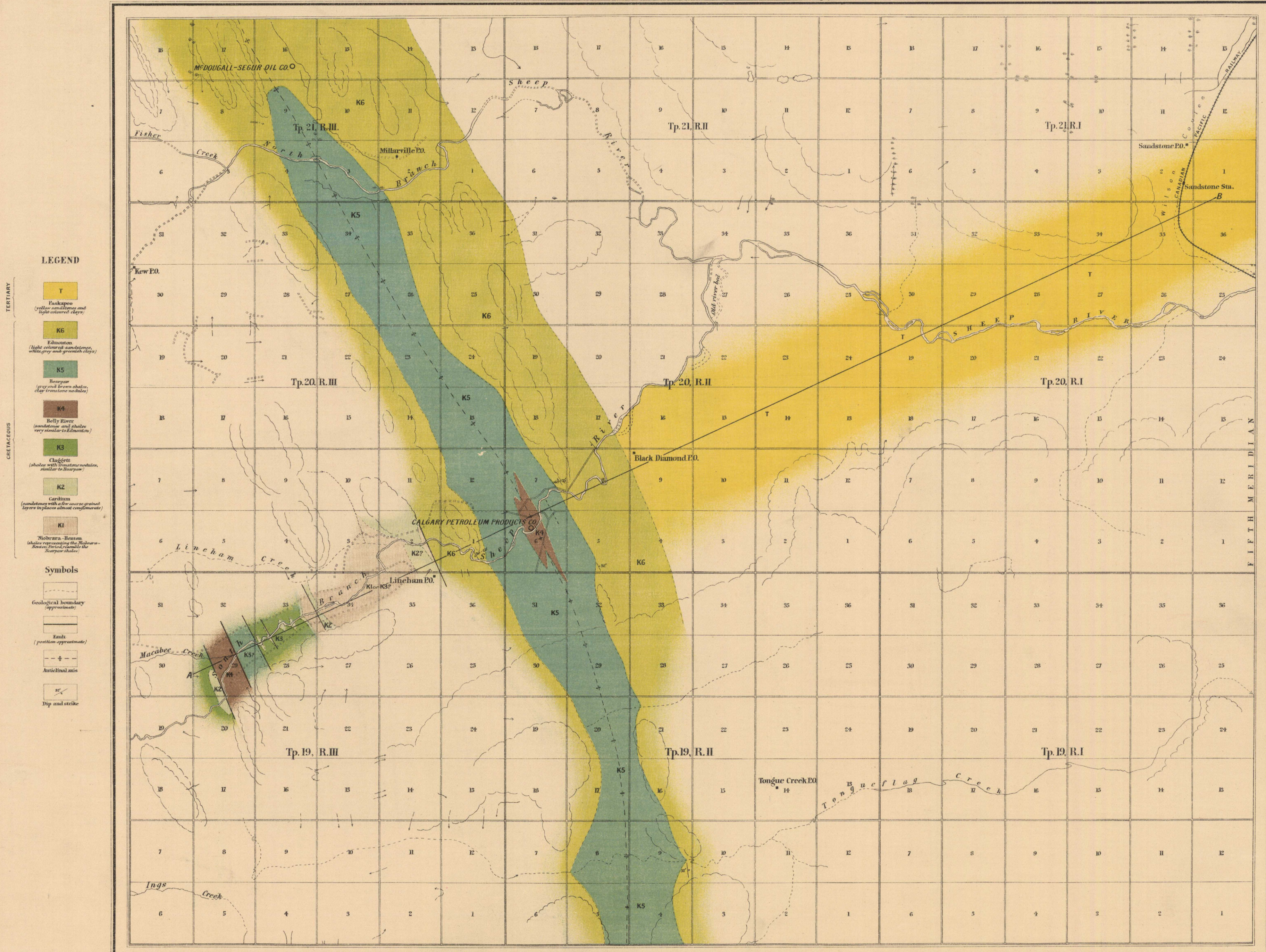

(sandstone and shales very similar to Edmonton)

(sandstone with a few coarse grained layers in places almost conglomerate)

(shales representing the Mohrara-Benton, transitional to the Roupar shales)
