DATA—Wheat Transverse from Hardscrable to Sugar Creek diggings by S. P. Tuck, Sept. 4th, 1885. Track surveys on Mustang Creek, Sugar Creek and Cooper's Gulch by A. Bowman Sept. 7th, 1886. Track surveys from Sugar Creek pass camp to Mt. Wiley, Sept. 7th, 1886, and from Dred's Canon along Slough and Dragon Creeks to Dragon Mt., Sept. 9th, 1886, by J. McEvoy. Transit work and topographical Sketches on Mt. Wiley, Sep. 7th, 1886, and on Dragon Mountain, Sept. 10th, 1886, &c., by J. McEvoy.
