 Instrumentally surveyed lines as follows:—Line of Canadian Pacific Railway, as measured for Base and surveys within the Railway Belt, by Topographical Survey Branch, British Columbia Government Land Surveys, chiefly about Okanagan Lake and White Valley. Observations for latitude, azimuth, and surveys of Adams and Shuswap Lakes, by G. M. Dawson. Apart from the above sources of information, the geographical outlines, with the whole of the topography, depend upon triangulation, traverse-surveys and a stadia by J. M. Evoy.
