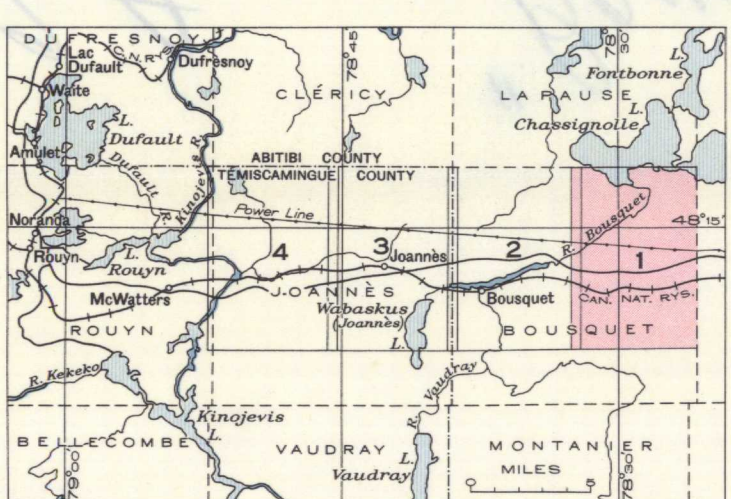


LEGEND

- PROTEROZOIC (LATE PRECAMBRIAN)**
- 13 Quartz gabbro
 - 12a, 12b albitite, quartz syenite and quartz syenite porphyry
 - 11 Granodiorite, quartz diorite
 - 10 Diorite and quartz diorite
- ARCHAIC (EARLY PRECAMBRIAN)**
- 9 Greywacke, stratified tuff (chiefly near north contact); beds of magnetite and iron formation
 - 8 Conglomerate (In Bousquet Township conglomerate lies mainly at or near the base of the Cadillac group; in western Joannès Township conglomerate occurs well up in the group)
 - 7 Andesitic to rhyolitic tuff and lava, largely altered to chlorite and sericite schist and phyllite; 7a, slaty chlorite tuff and sericite-carbonate schist; 7b, chiefly massive acidic lava and rhyolite breccia
 - 6 Chiefly porphyritic rhyolite, in part altered to sericite schist; basic lava and tuff
 - 5 Chiefly andesite; basalt and dacite; allied pyroclastic rocks; minor diorite and thin bands of rhyolite; 5a, porphyritic andesite; 5b, andesite agglomerate; 5c, talc-chlorite schist; serpentine, mica schist and highly sheared agglomeratic conglomerate. (The south band is the Cadillac belt)
 - 3 Conglomerate with interbedded greywacke
 - 2 Greywacke, in part altered to mica schist
 - 1 Chiefly altered andesitic lava; tuff and breccia; may include some diorite
- Beds of magnetite and iron formation

- Area within which the geology is deduced from underground workings and drill-holes
- Diamond drill-holes
