In the construction of this plan the lines in full are from surveys by D^r R. W. Ellis and N. L. Giroux, P.L.S., which were made with prismatic compass and chain or by micrometer; the dotted township, range and lot lines are taken from various plans thus:—
 Ireland, from Fournier's surveys 1820, variation corrected to date.
 Coleraine, from Poudrier's surveys, 1867.
 Thetford, from McCarthy's surveys, 1800.
 Wolfestown, from Smith's surveys, 1820.
 The Quebec Central Railway is from the plan furnished by the Department of Crown Lands, Quebec.
 Magnetic Variation, in 1888, 16° 36' W.

Large portions of the surface being covered by drift, the outlines of the serpentine ridges as indicated by the shading are not supposed to definitely limit the areas of these rocks.
