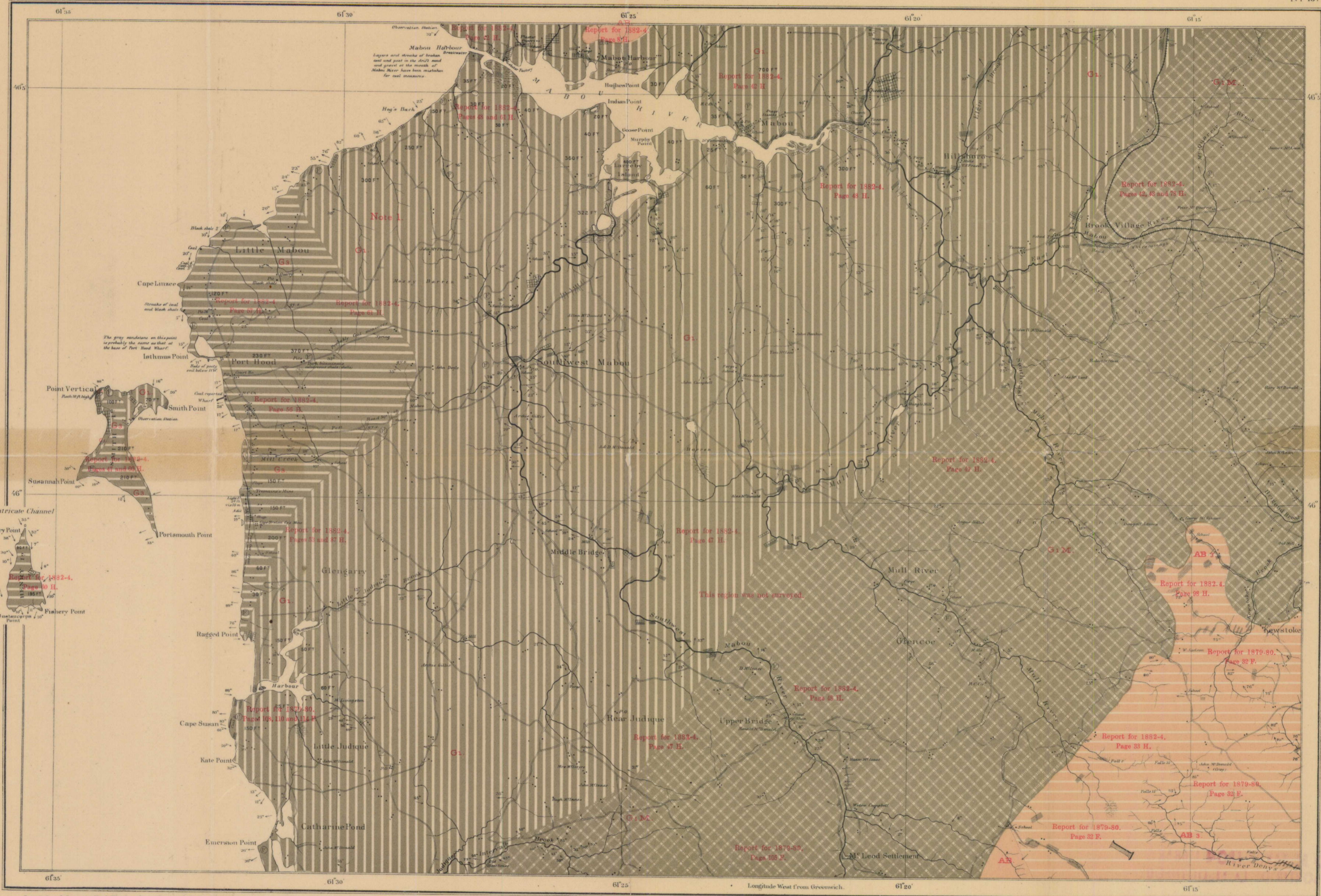

Note 1.—The boundary of the area G1 on the mainland is indefinite and the faults affecting the structure obscure. A fault probably runs from Ragged Point to the shore between Hog's Back and Little Mabou, and G1 perhaps extends northeast to John McPherson's and the Hog's Back School House.
