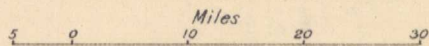

Queen Charlotte series. (Cretaceous)



Chiefly metamorphic rocks of the Vancouver group and intrusive granitic rocks, with small areas of Queen Charlotte sediments and dykes and "caps" of Tertiary volcanics and intrusives.
