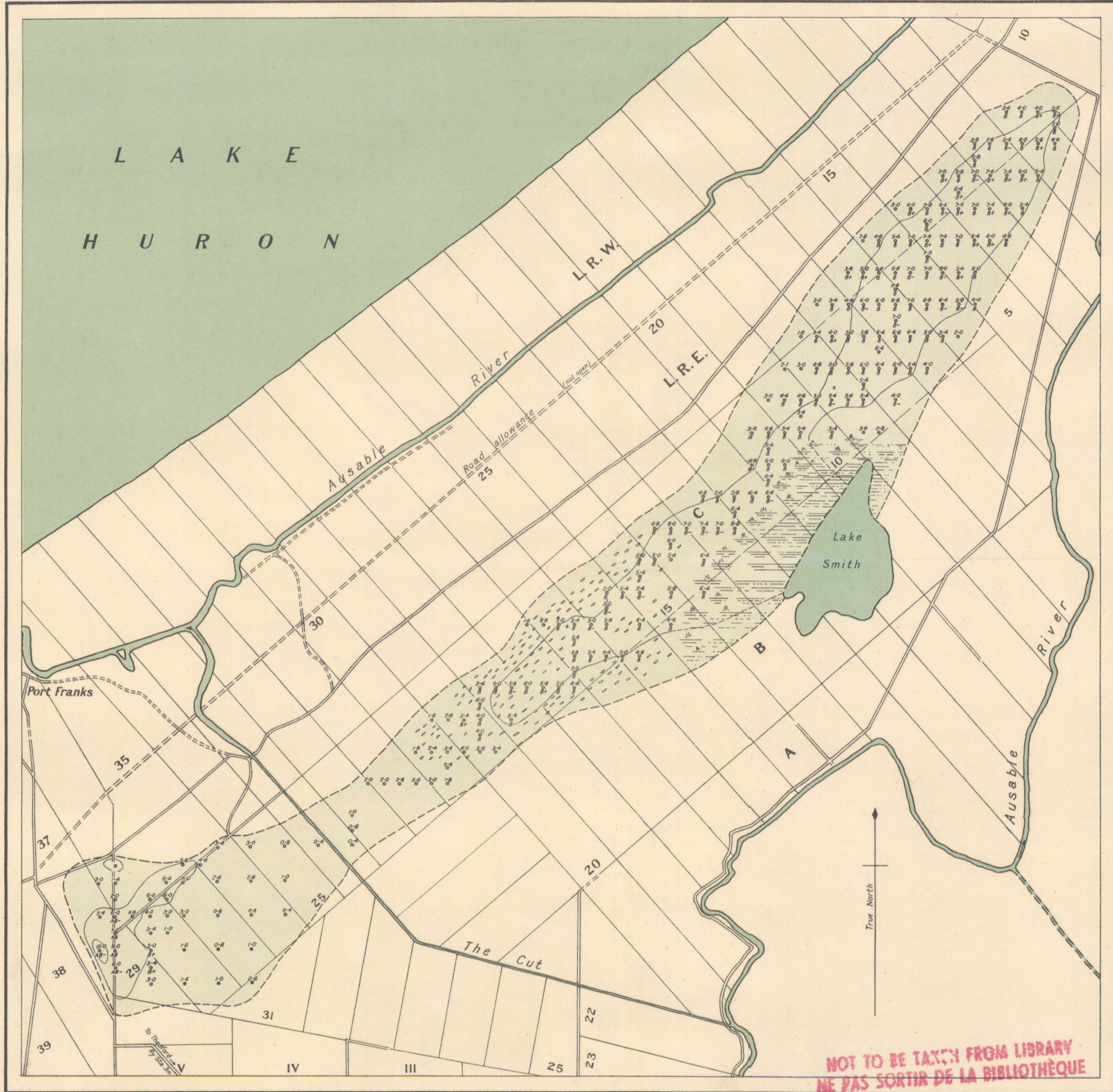

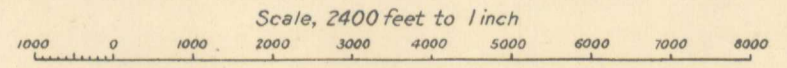
Legend

Classification of Peat

- A } highly humified, good
- AB- } Peat more or less suitable for the manufacture of peat fuel
- AB+ } well humified
- AB } fairly well humified
- B+ } less well humified, poor
- B } not suitable for the manufacture of peat fuel or peat litter
- B- } slightly humified, poor
- BC+ } Peat more or less suitable for the manufacture of peat litter
- BC } fairly free from humus
- C+ } practically free from humus, good
- C } from humus, good
- C- }
