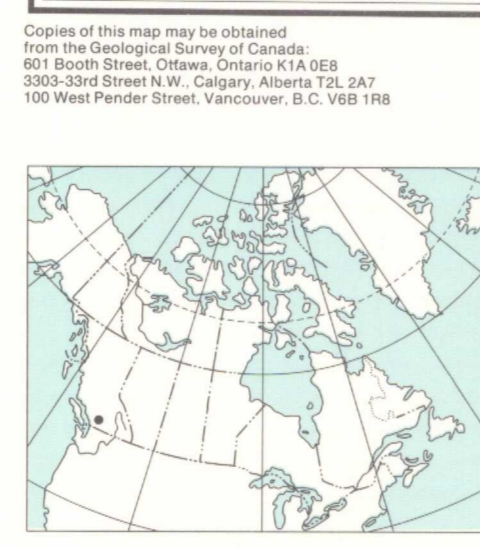
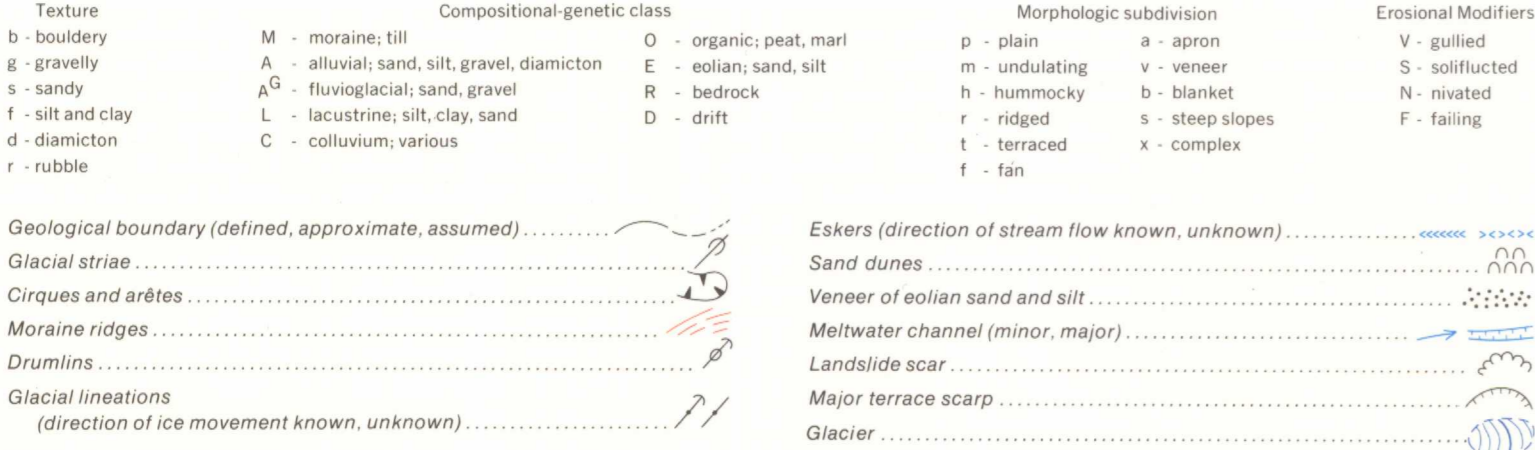


LEGEND AND DESCRIPTION OF TERRAIN UNITS
