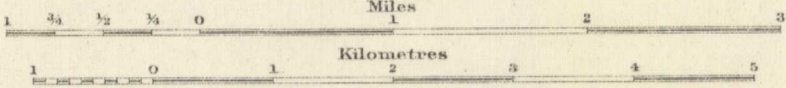

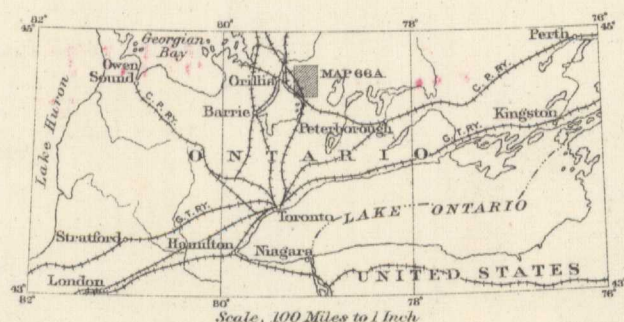
**BRECHIN SHEET**
