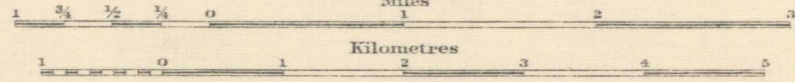

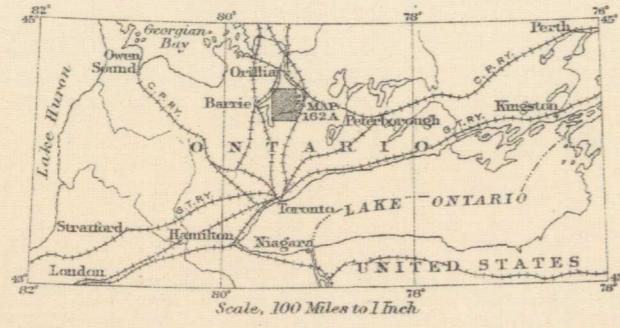
SUTTON SHEET
