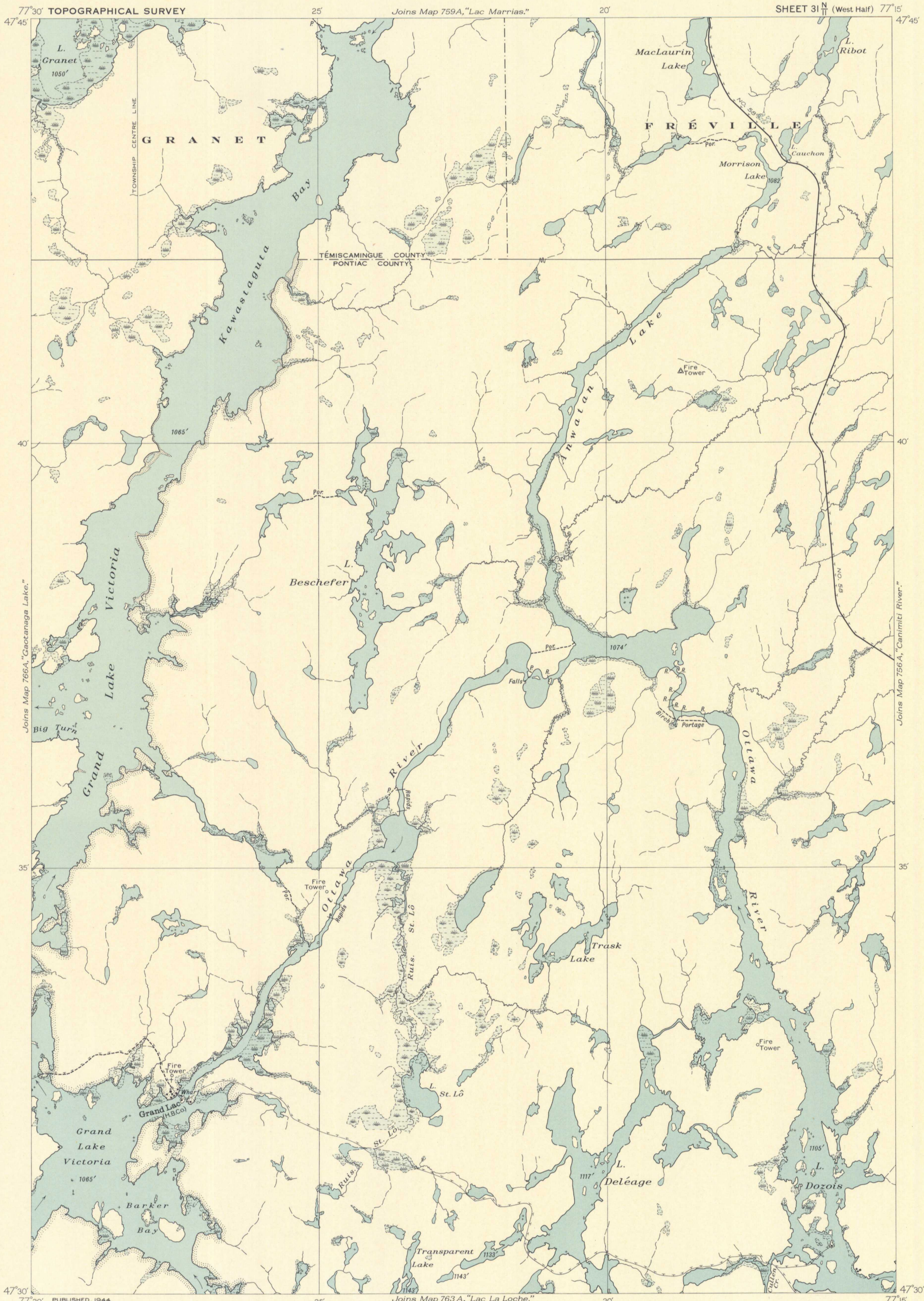

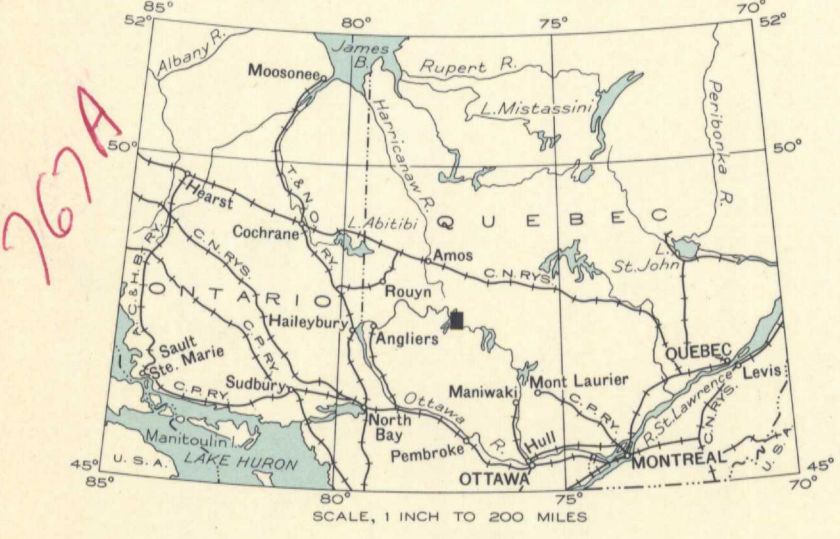


MAP 767A
