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This map shows the data of induced intensity of magnetization in the area of Kenora-Bissett-Red Lake. This area, approximately 150 by 150 km, in western Ontario and southeastern Manitoba, includes portions of the English River gneiss belt, and the Kenora and Red Lake greenstone belts.
