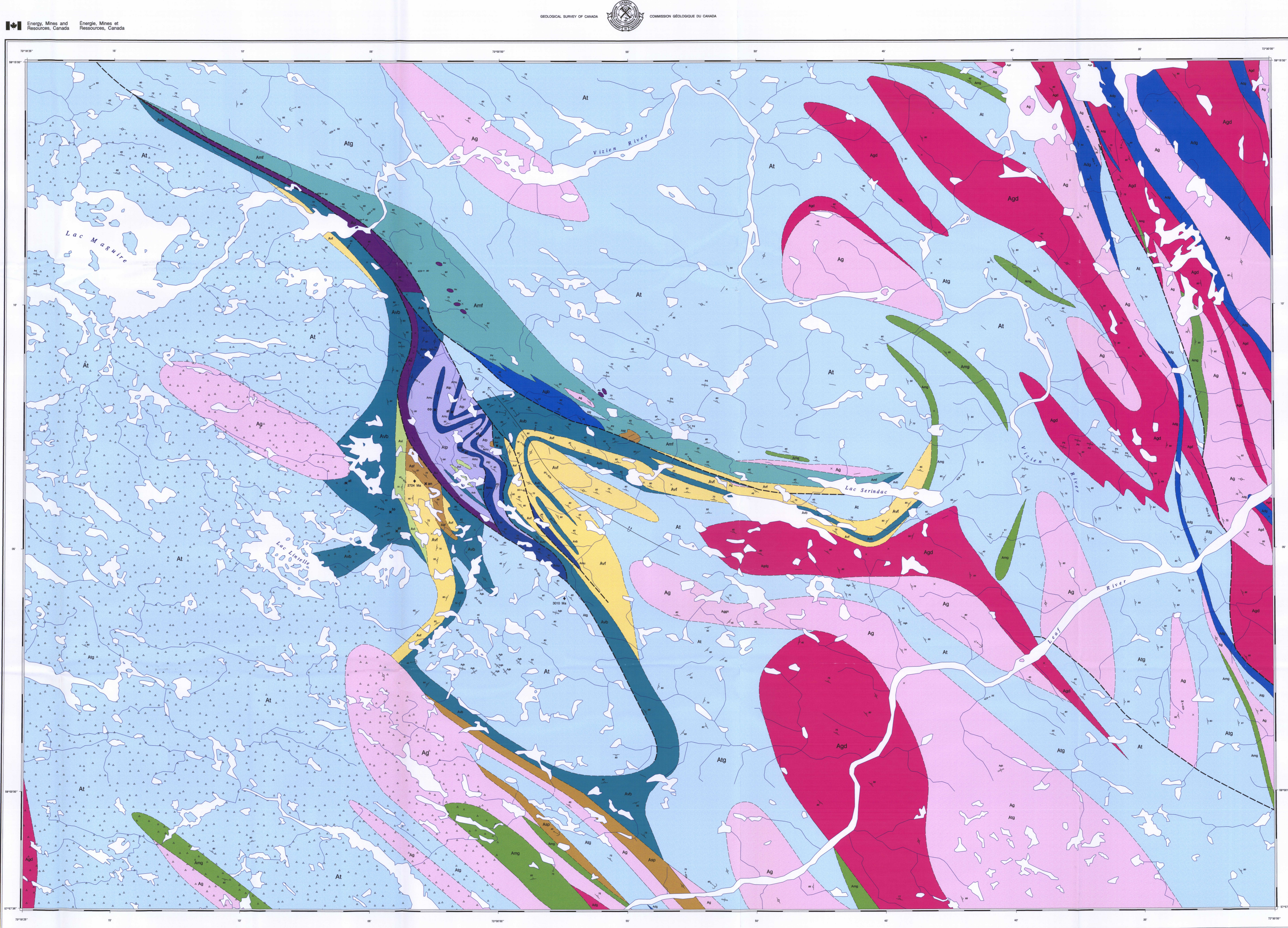

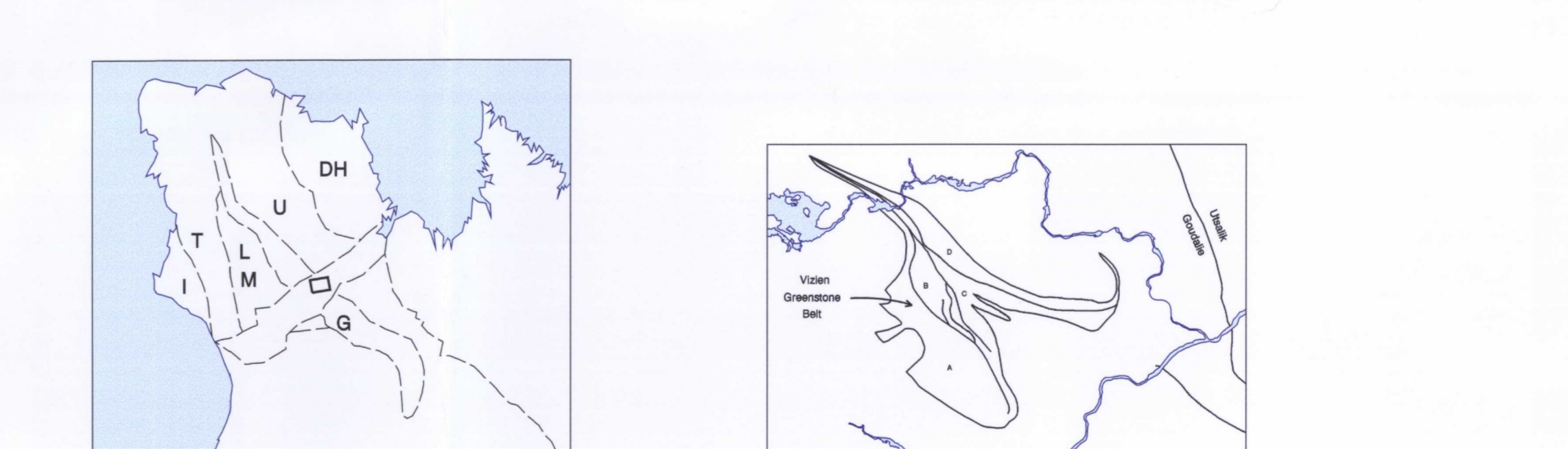


Fig. 1. Location map showing the location of the Vizion Greenstone Belt in the province of Québec.
