

RECONNAISSANCE MAP OF A PORTION OF THE WEST KOOTANIE DISTRICT BRITISH COLUMBIA.

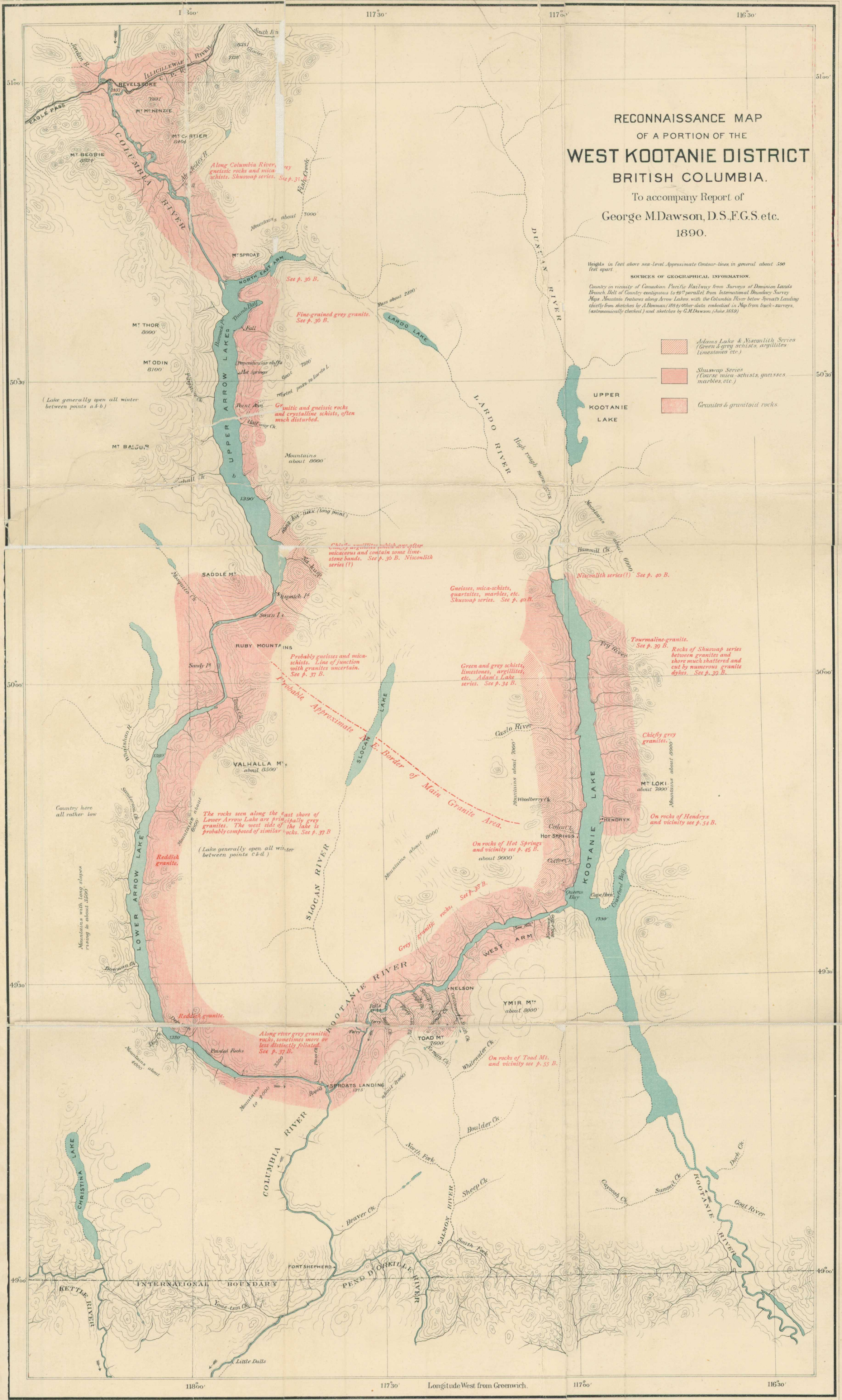

Heights in feet above sea-level. Approximate Contour-lines in general about 500 feet apart.

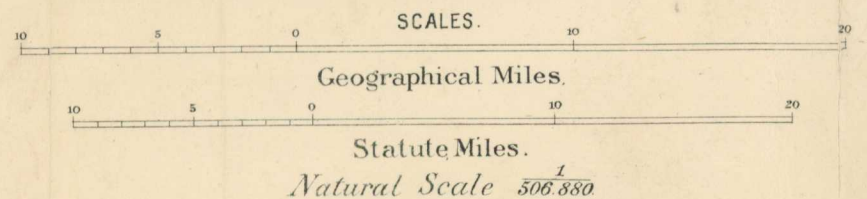
SOURCES OF GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION.

Country in vicinity of Canadian Pacific Railway from Surveys of Dominion Lands Branch. Belt of Country contiguous to 49° parallel from International Boundary Survey Maps. Mountain features along Arrow Lakes, with the Columbia River below Sprouts Landing chiefly from sketches by A. Bonanza (1884) other data embodied in Map from track-surveys, (astronomically checked) and sketches by G.M. Dawson, (June 1889).

- Adams Lake & Nisconlith Series (Green & grey schists, argillites, limestones, etc.)
- Shuswap Series (Coarse mica-schists, gneisses, marbles, etc.)
- Granites & granitoid rocks.
