

This radiometric map of Nova Scotia is one of eight 1:500 000 regional compilation maps that include three channels of gamma ray spectrometry data (potassium, uranium and thorium) and a total gamma ray dose rate. The data were collected by the Airborne Gamma Ray Spectrometry (AGRS) system of the Geological Survey of Canada (GSC) and compiled into a digital format. 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This map was produced from processed data in accordance with the Cartographic Services Section Quality Management System, Ottawa, registered in the Quality System ISO 9001:2000 standards.

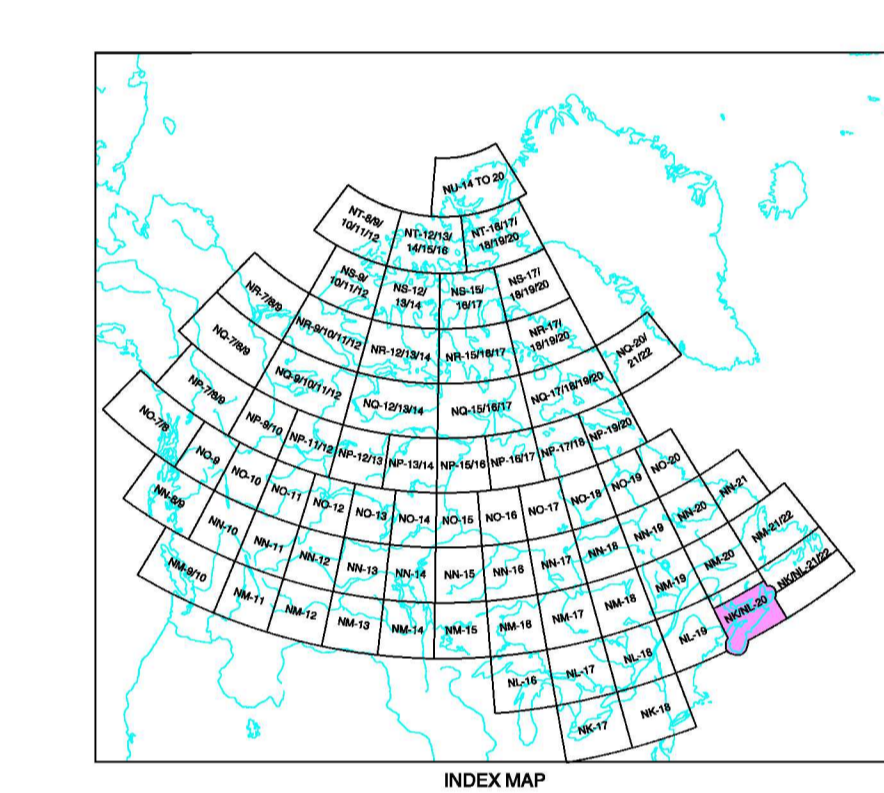
