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## General Information

The Geological Survey was established in 1842. Reports of Progress were issued from that date to 1885. Beginning in 1885 "Annual Reports" (new series) were published, the last being volume XVI for 1904. Since 1904 publications have been issued mainly as Memoirs, Bulletins, Summary Reports, Economic Geology Series, and Preliminary Papers. The series of Summary Reports, which was published annually, has been discontinued, that for 1933 being the last.

Recent administrative statements of the Geological Survey and the National Museum of Canada are found in the Annual Reports of the Department of Mines and Resources. A more detailed account of the museum activities may be found in the Annual Reports of the National Museum of Canada for 1926 and subsequent years. These reports were discontinued during the war, that for 1938-39 being the last published.

The present list overlaps the information contained in Ferrier's catalogue of 1845-1917 in order to preserve the continuity of the various series. It is not a catalogue nor index, but a list of the more recent publications of the Bureau of Geology and Topography.
