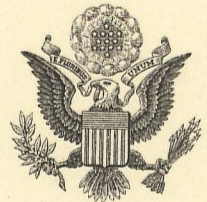


# INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY

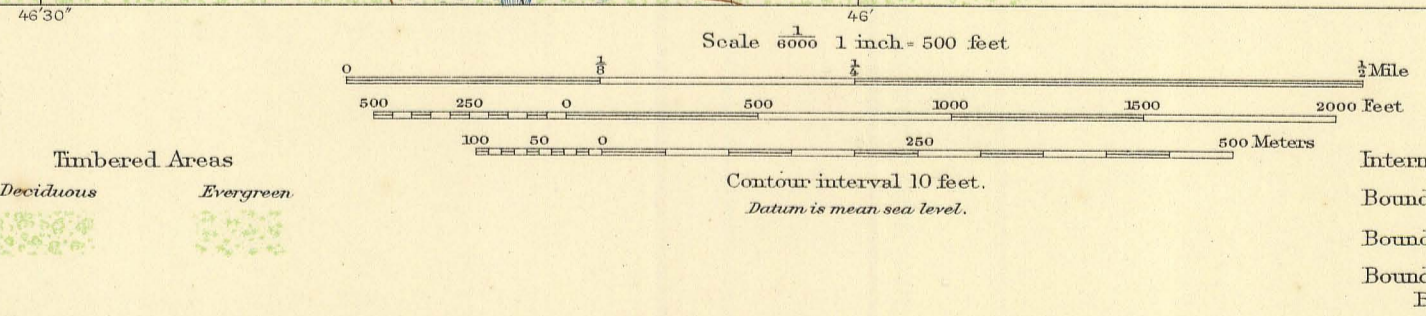
