

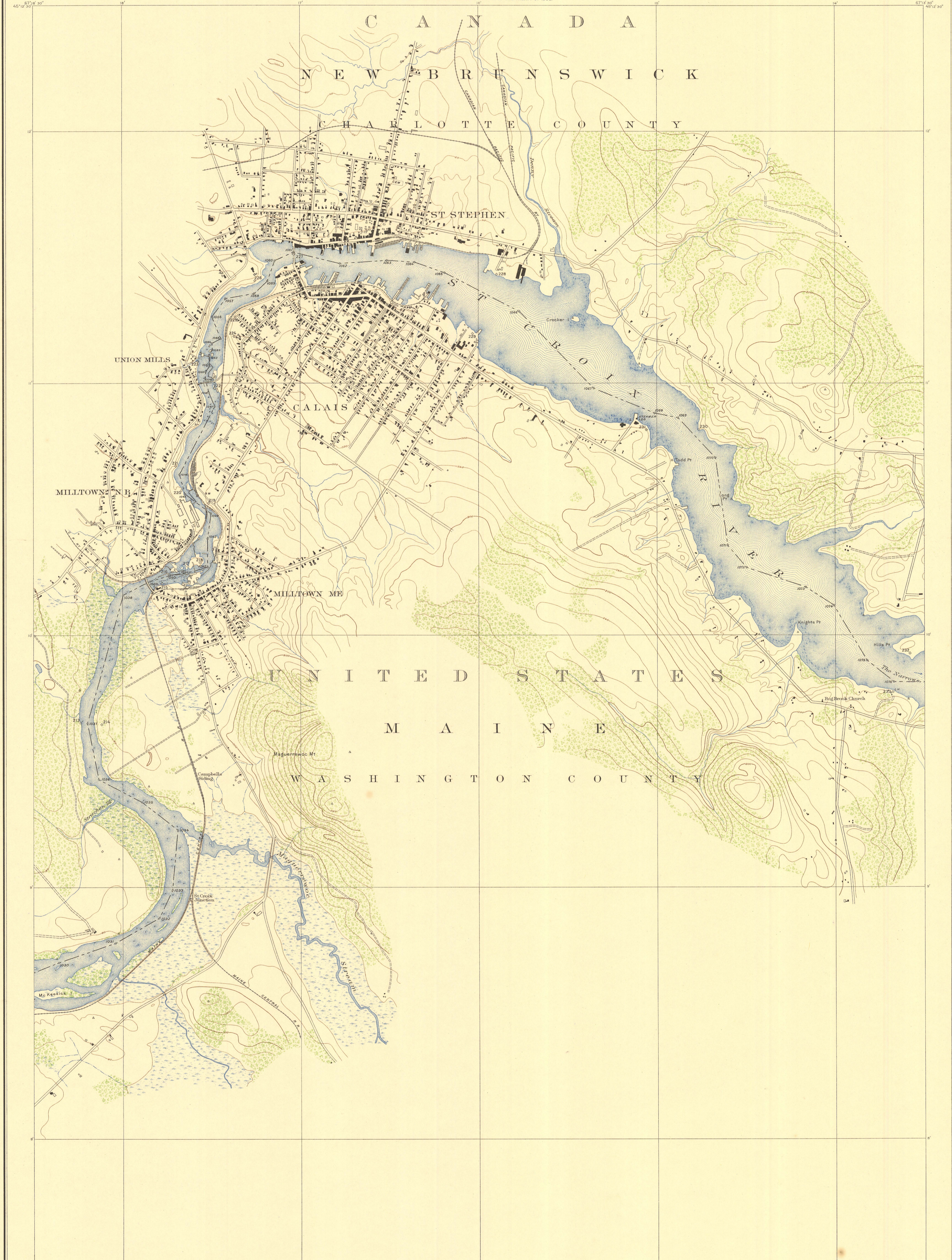
INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY

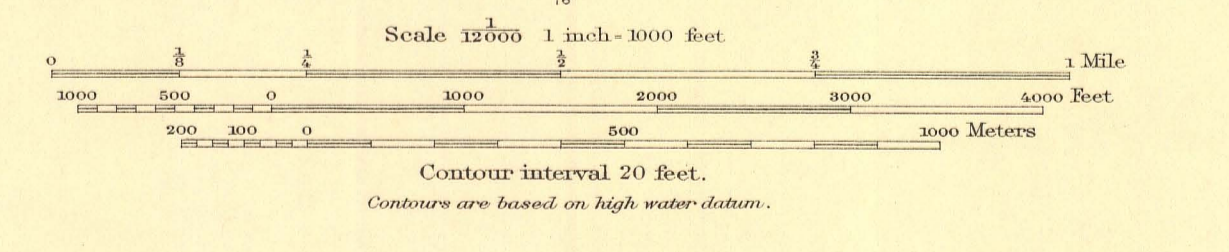
