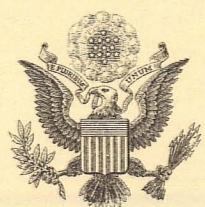


INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY

FROM THE NORTHWESTERNMOST POINT OF LAKE OF THE WOODS TO LAKE SUPERIOR

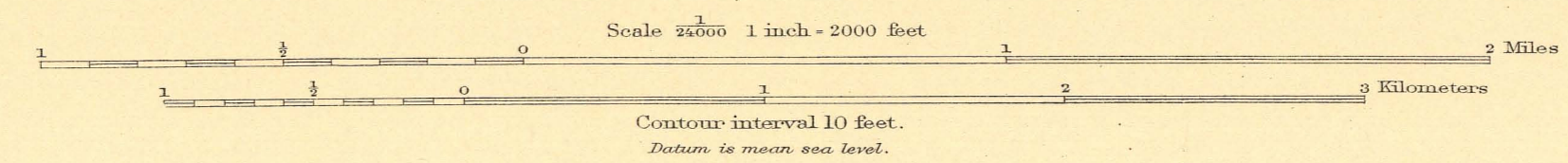
