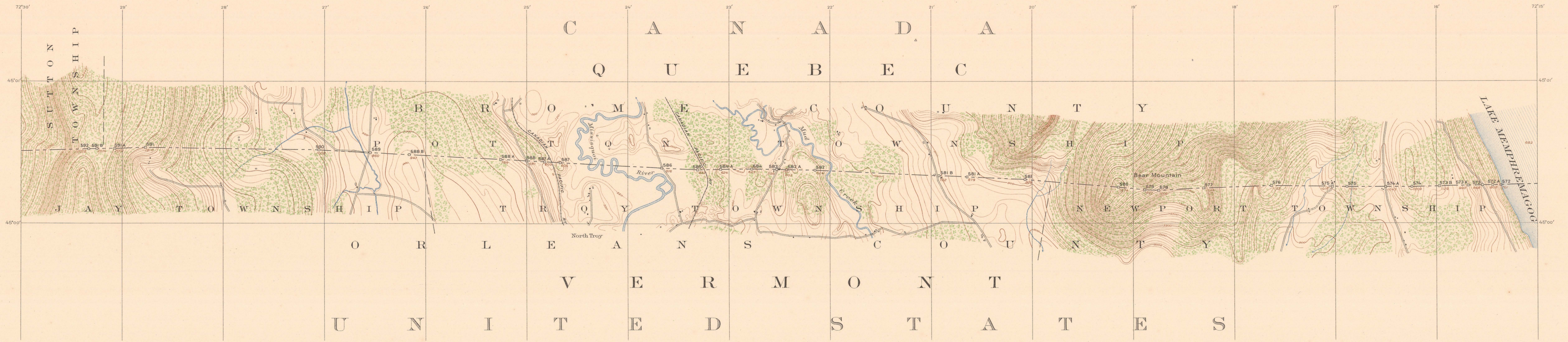


INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY

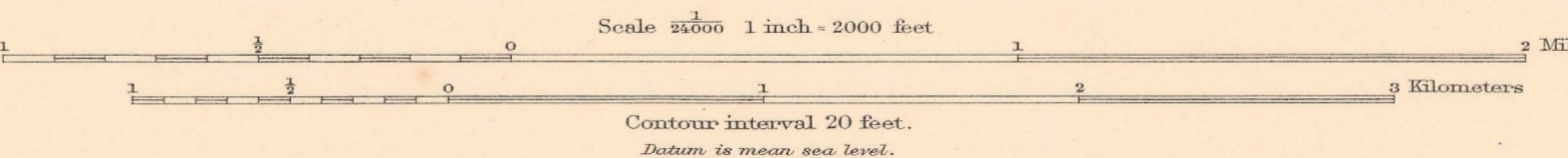
