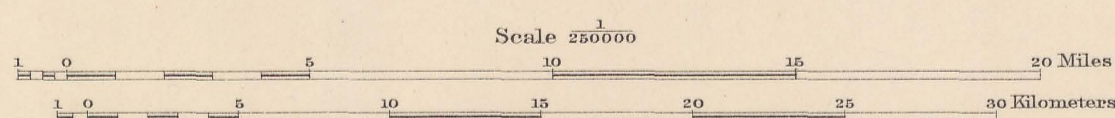


INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY
