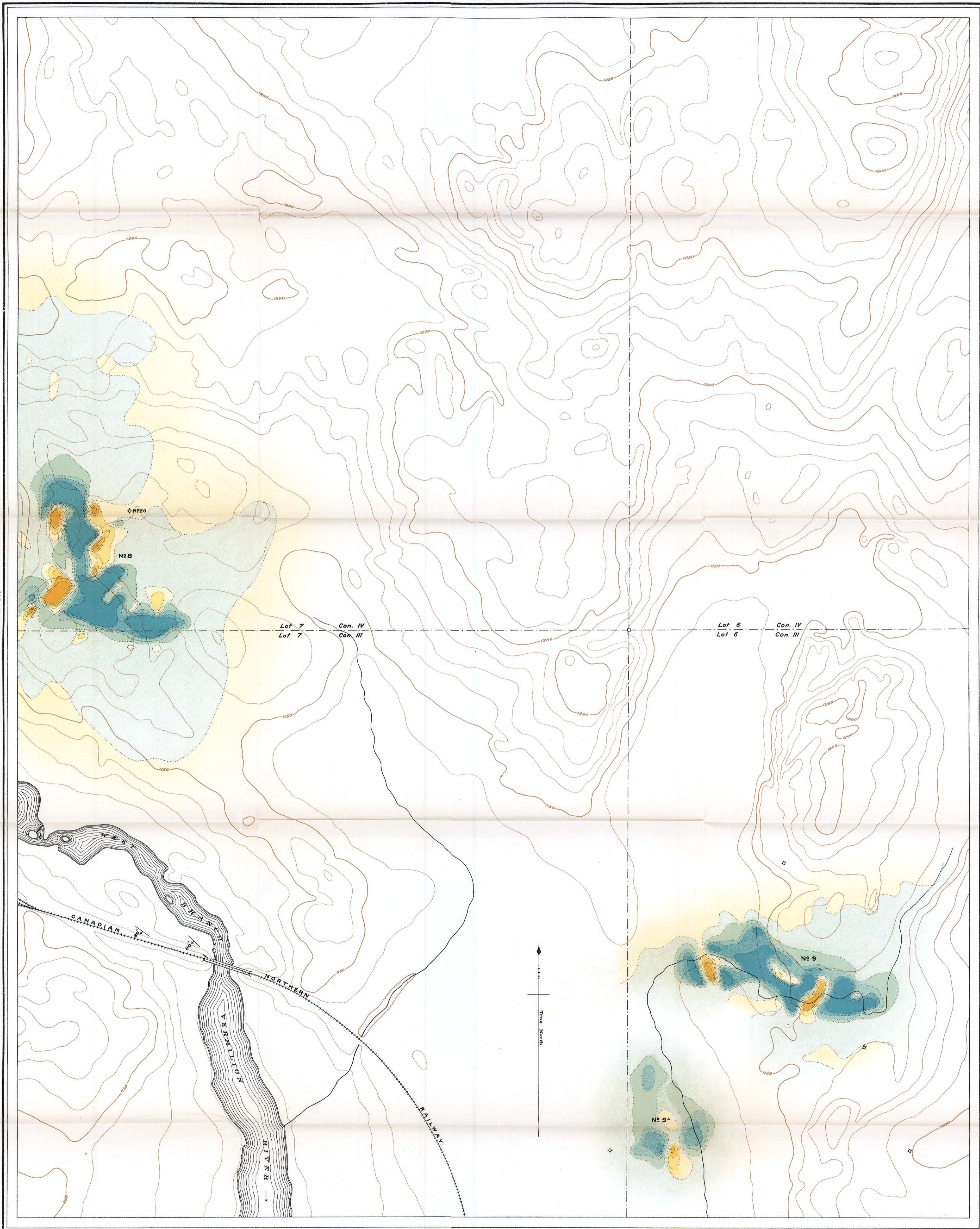

Magnetic declination about 6°55' west

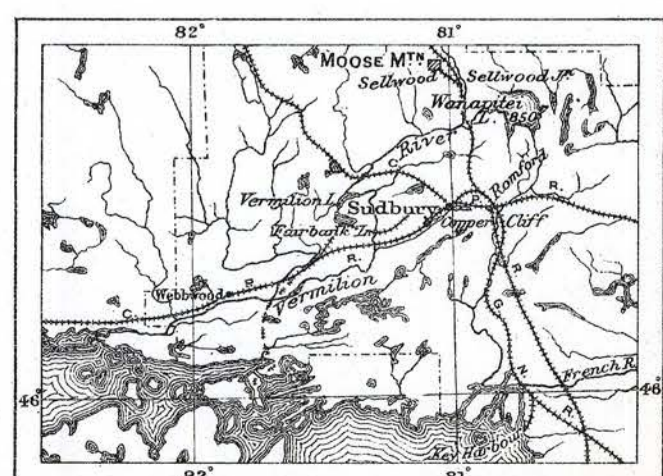

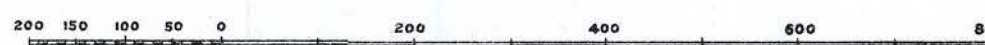
