



NOTE: It is not possible to map this large area of the globe on a uniform scale. This map is shown on a conic projection, which means that the scale along the meridians is constant (at 300 miles to one inch) but the scale in other directions varies. Hence, the north-south scale may be used for ordinary purposes, but for other purposes, the scale in other directions may be used.
