



NOTE: It is not possible to map this large area of the globe on a uniform scale. This map is drawn on a conic projection, which means that the scale along the meridians is constant (at 300 miles to one inch) but the scale in other directions varies. Near the north pole the map will be considered true to scale, and for that part of the map within the 40° latitude circle the scale may be taken, with sufficient accuracy for ordinary purposes, to be 300 miles to one inch.
