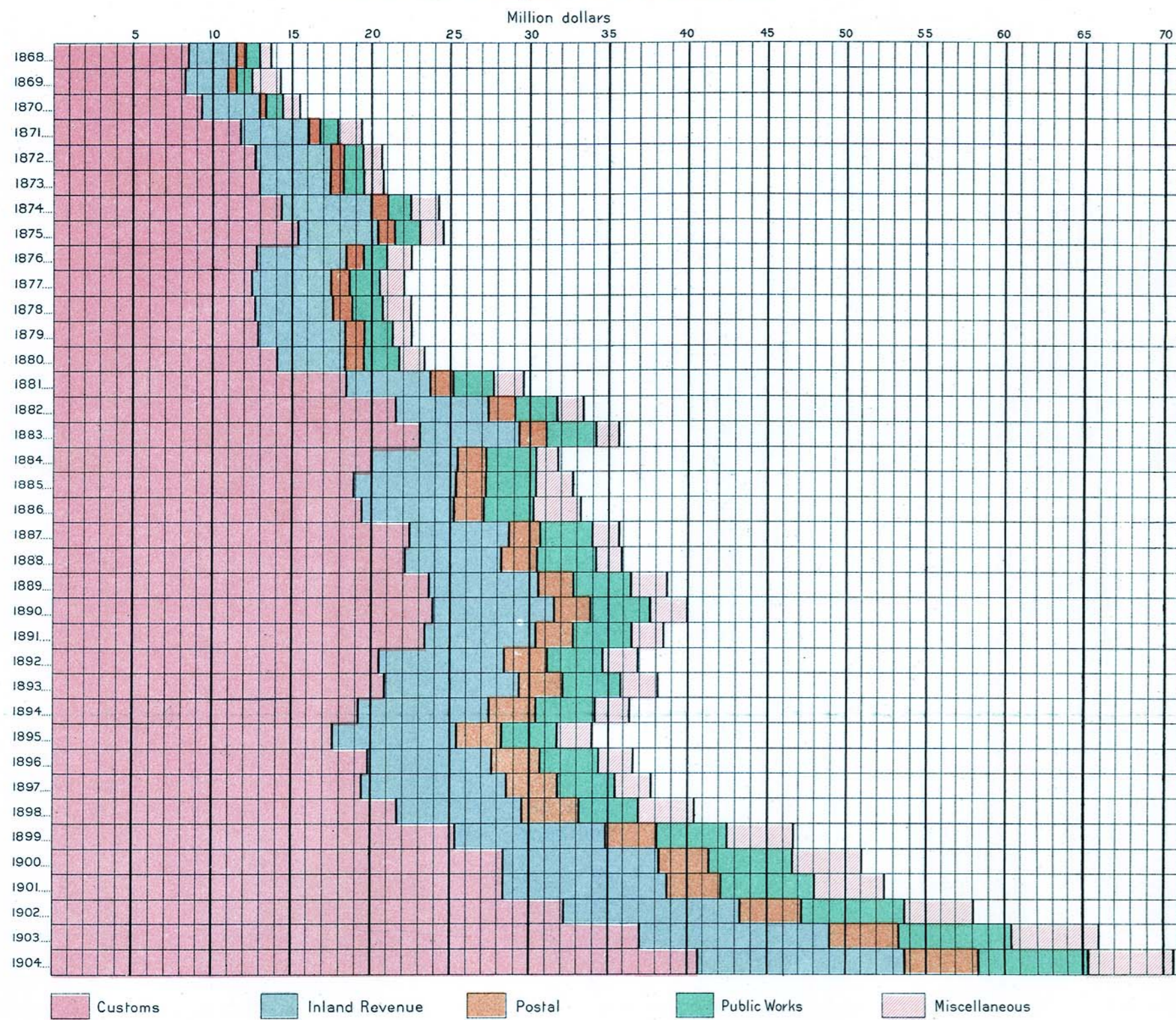


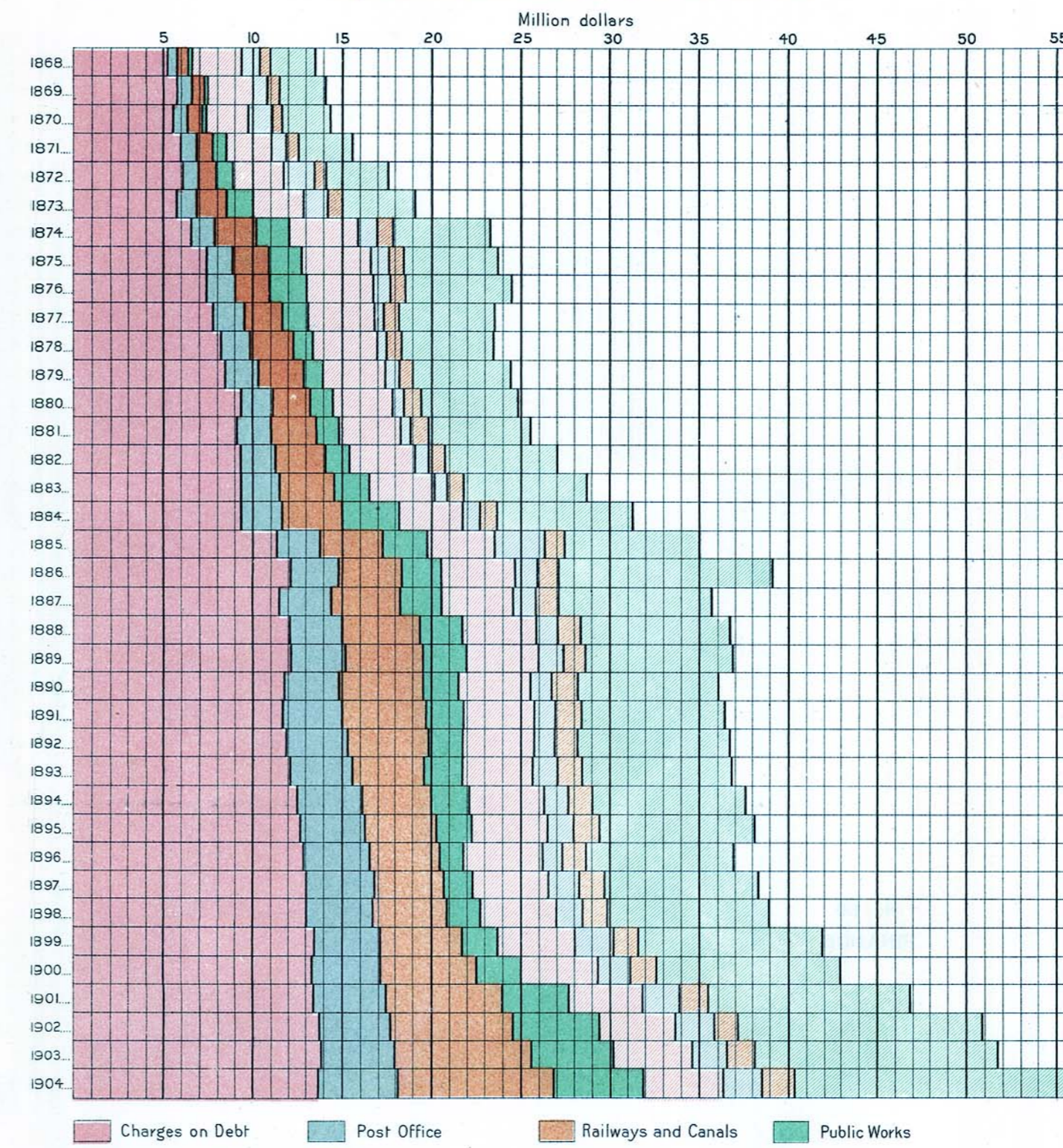

Revenue for each year since Confederation

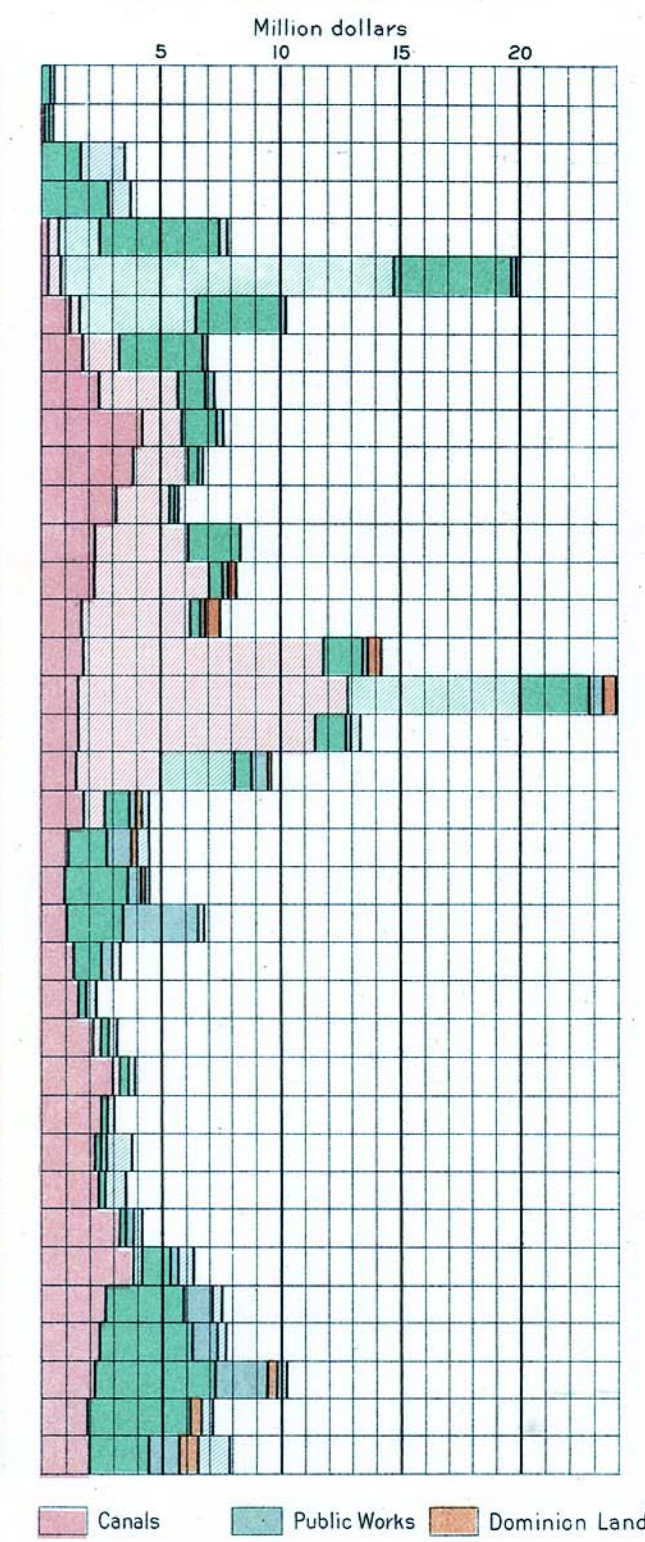

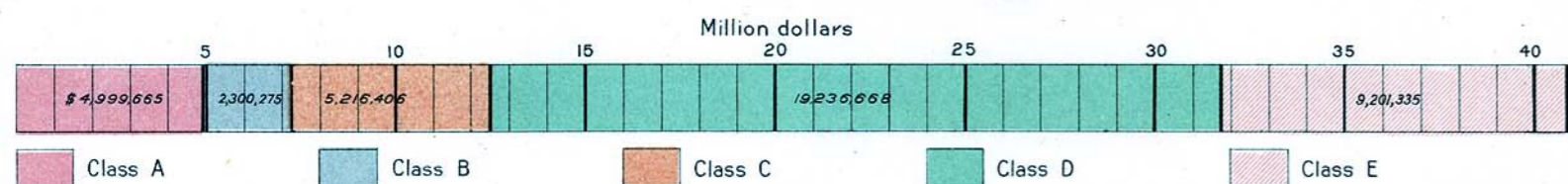
Expenditure on account of Consolidated Fund



Expenditure on Capital account

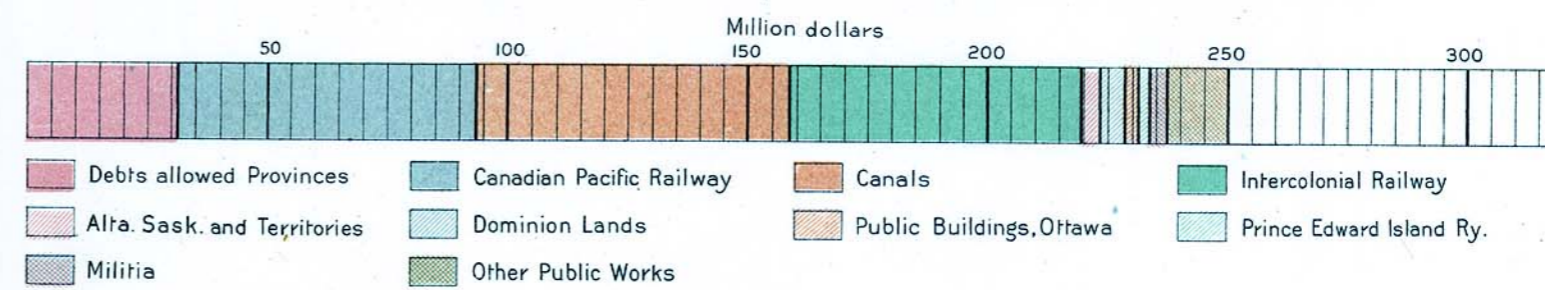


Customs Revenue, 1904

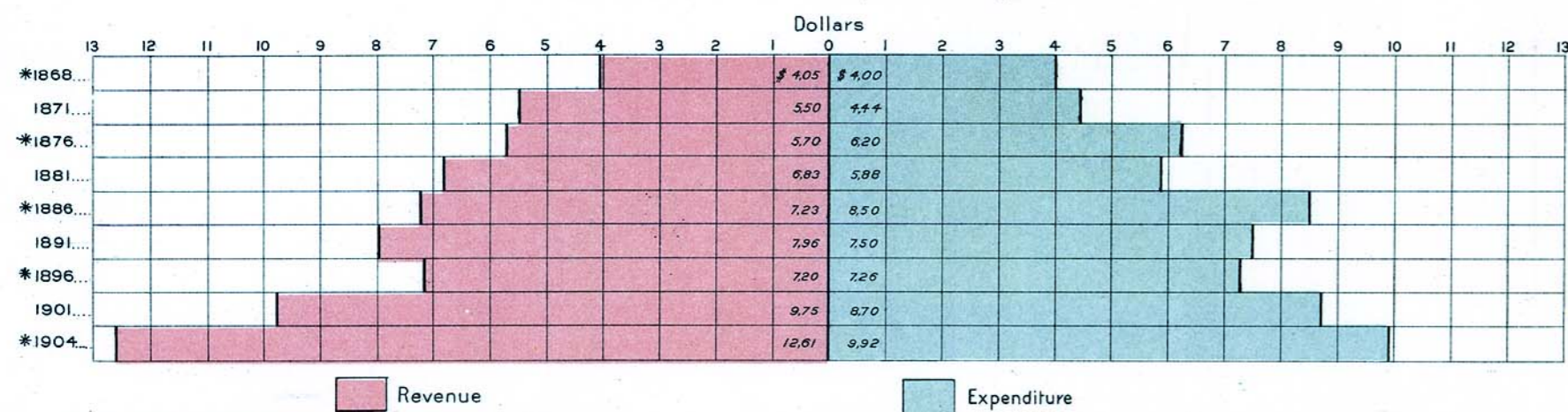


Class "A" Articles of Food and Live Stock.
