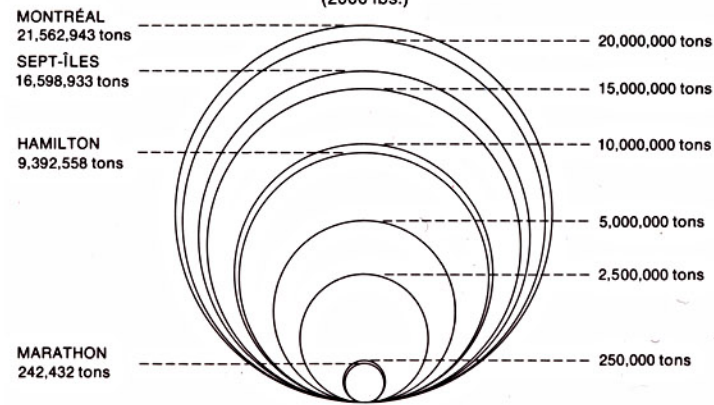
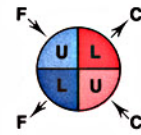


### SHIPPING - EASTERN CANADA, 1964

#### SHORT TONS OF CARGO (2000 lbs.)



#### COLOUR KEY



L = Loaded  
U = Unloaded  
F = Foreign ports  
C = Other Canadian Ports

The arrows signify shipment to or from a Canadian port.

- Over 50% L → C
- Over 50% U → C
- Over 50% L → F
- Over 50% U → F
- No case over 50%

A port handling more than 240,000 tons is shown by a circle, the area of which is proportional to the tonnage handled at the port.

Ports handling smaller tonnages are shown as follows:  
○ 5000 - 49,999 tons    ○ 50,000 - 240,000 tons  
Ports handling less than 5000 tons are not shown
