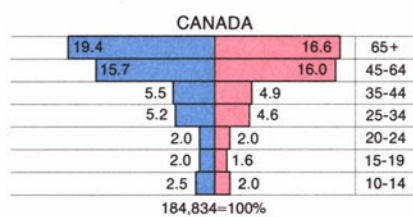


UNSCHOOLED POPULATION, 1961
BY AGE GROUP AND SEX

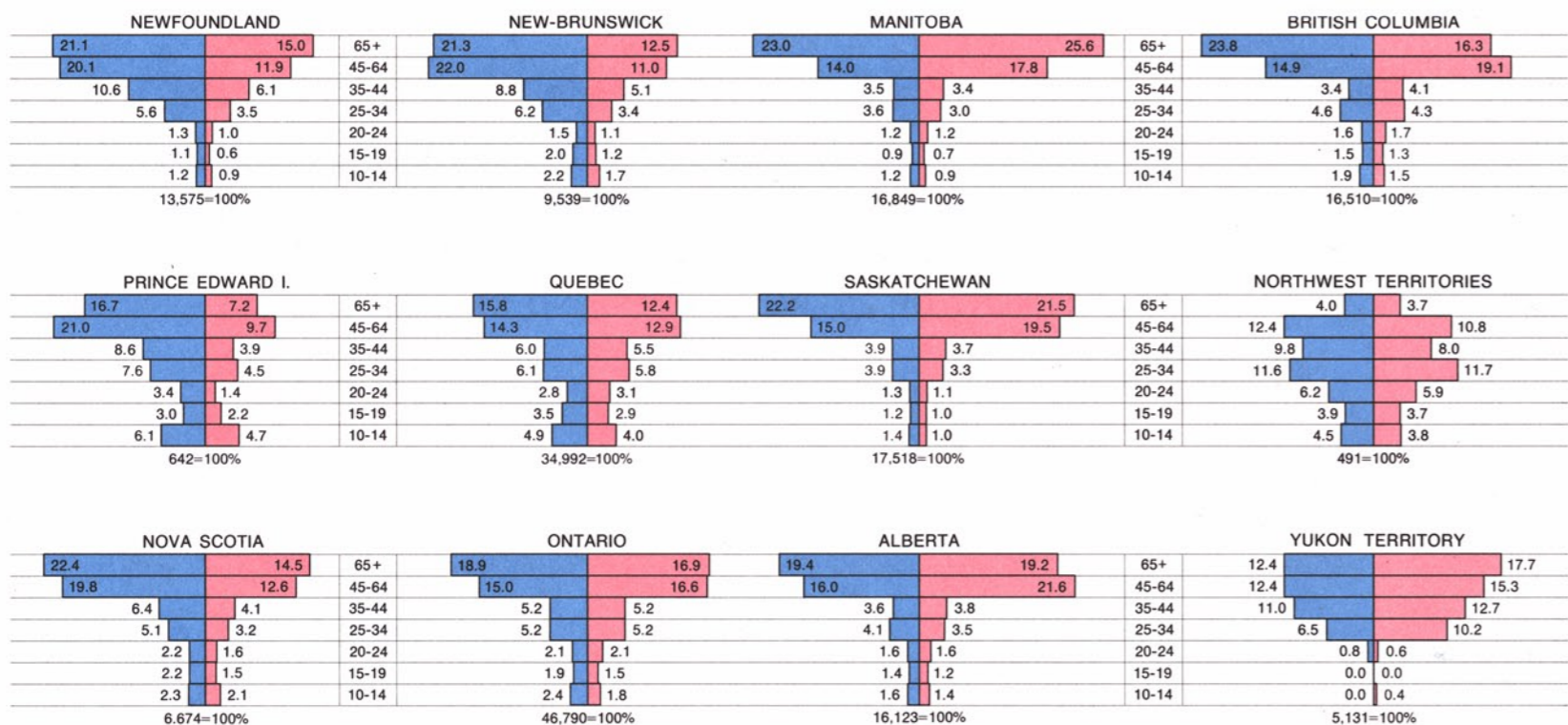

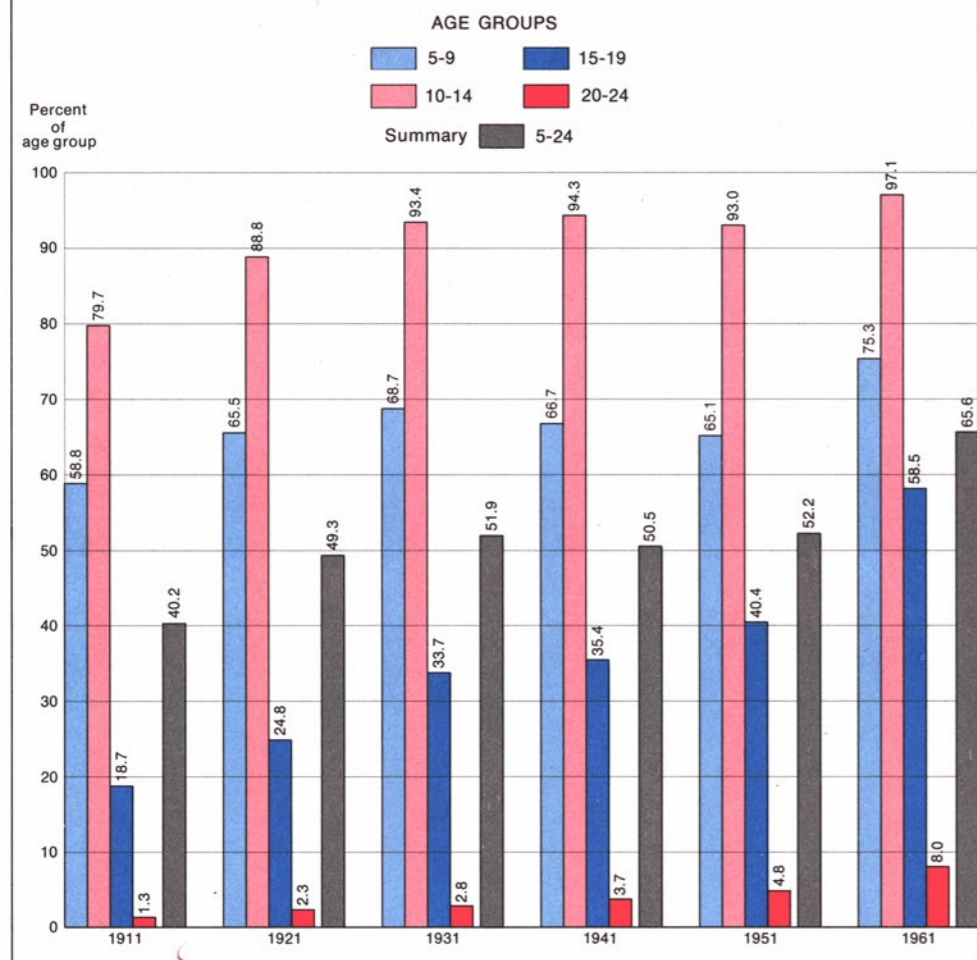
The individual bars express the uneducated population as percentages of the total uneducated population for each territorial unit.

Note: Uneducated persons are not necessarily illiterate.

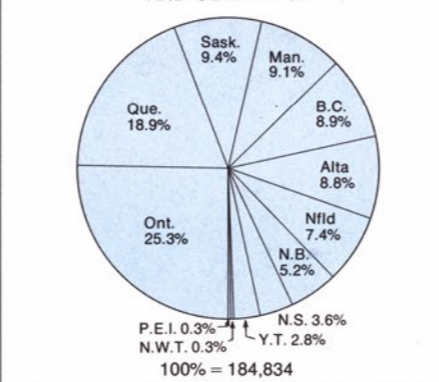

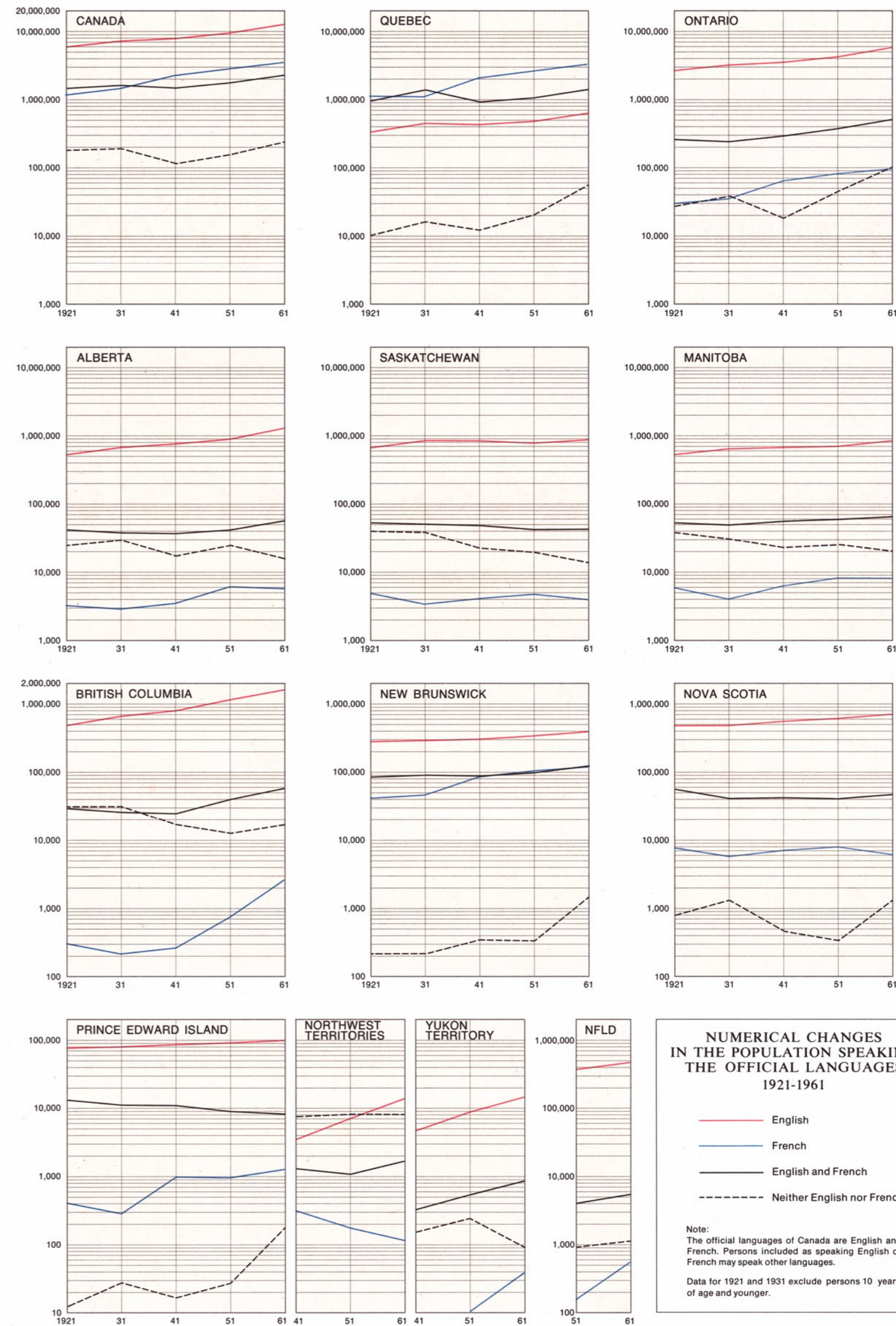
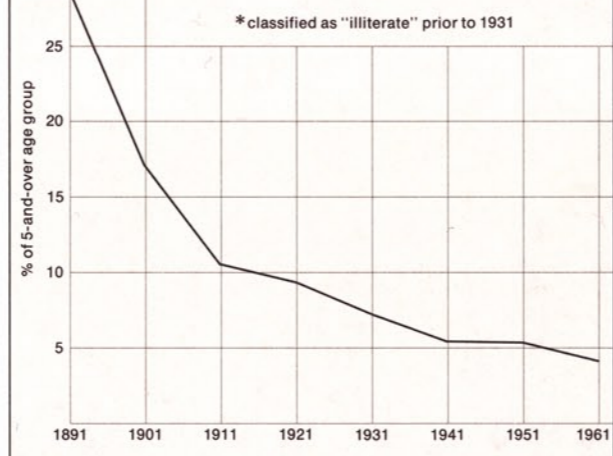
