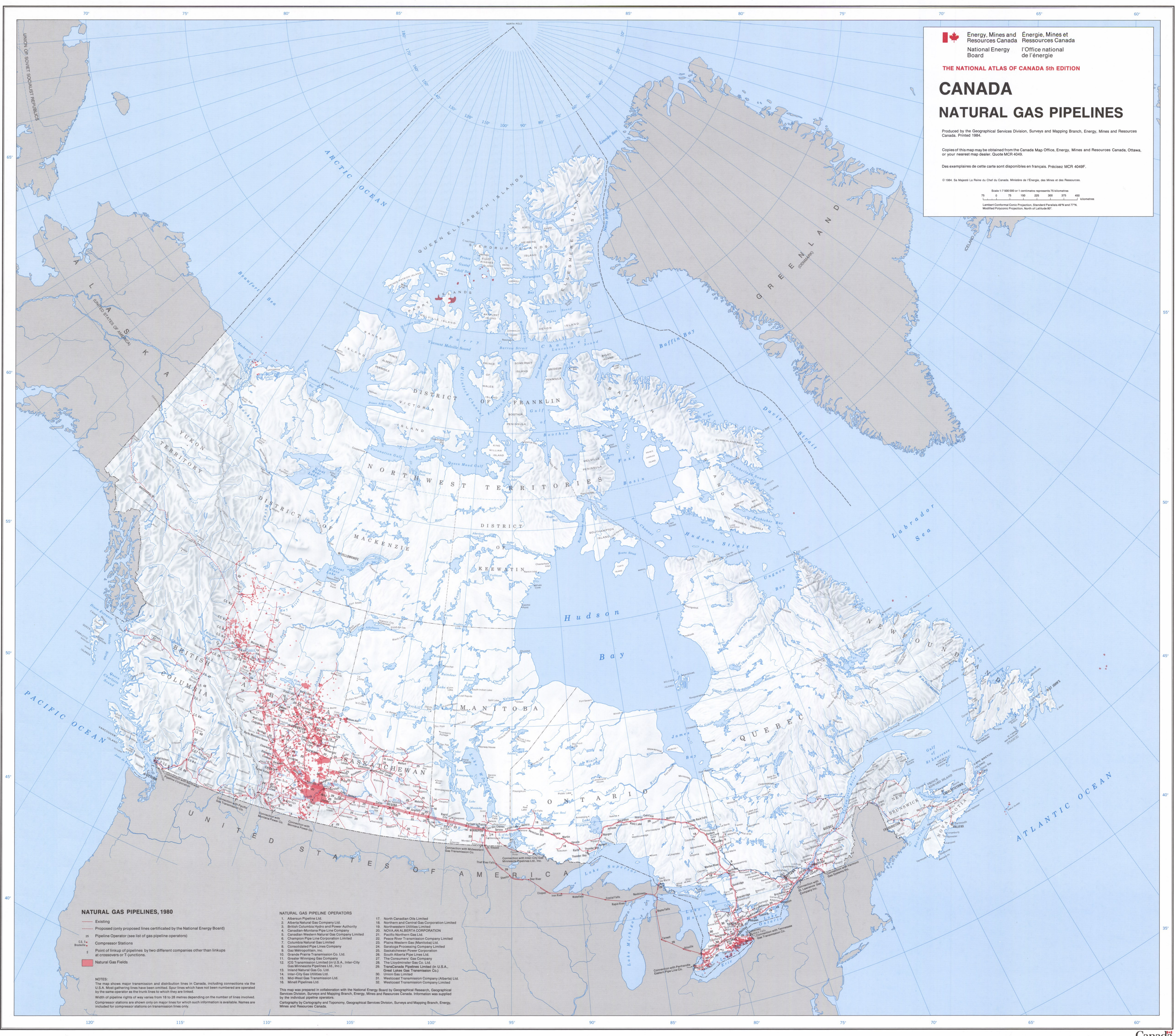
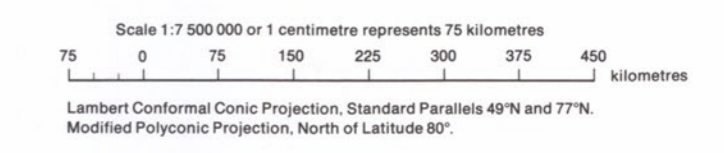

The map shows major transmission and distribution lines in Canada, including connections via the U.S.A. Most gathering lines have been omitted. Spur lines which have not been numbered are operated by the same operator as the trunk lines to which they are linked.
Width of pipeline rights of way varies from 18 to 28 metres depending on the number of lines involved.
Compressor stations are shown only on major lines for which such information is available. Names are included for compressor stations on transmission lines only.
