EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO OBTAIN A REFERENCE TO MARSHES 100 METRES
EXEMPLE DE LA METHODE EMPLOYEE POUR FIXER DES REPERES A 100 METRES PRES

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH - EGLISE (as above) (ci-dessus)

SETTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point.

NOTITUDE: Note the height of the line established to point.

ESTIMATE: Estimate the number of a square from this line eastward to point.

REMARK: Estimate the number of diameters of the circle between this number and the line in direction east.

SETTING: Read number on grid line immediately below point.

NOTITUDE: Note the height of the line established to point.

ESTIMATE: Estimate the number of a square from this line northward to point.

REMARK: Estimate the number of diameters of the circle between this number and the line in direction north.
