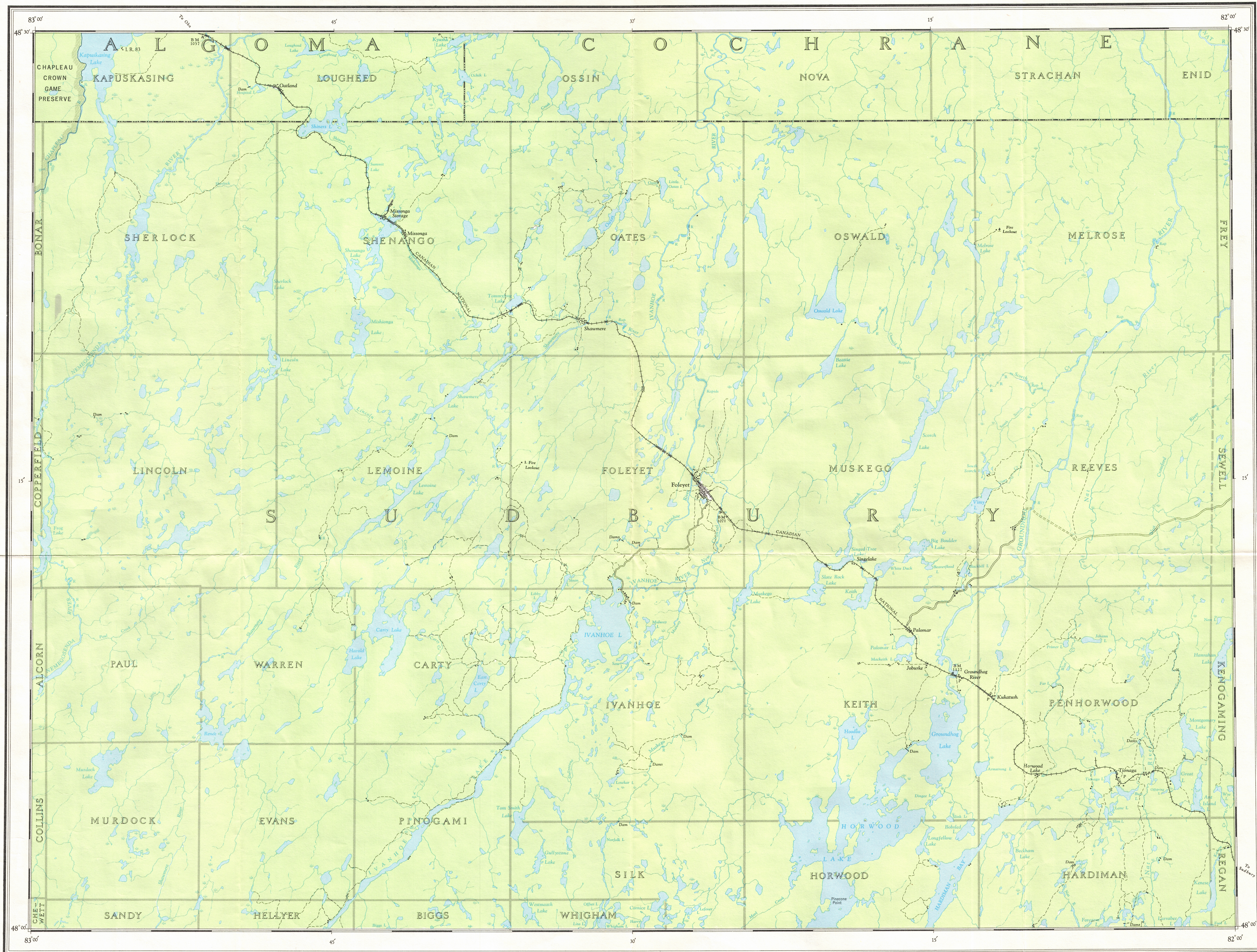
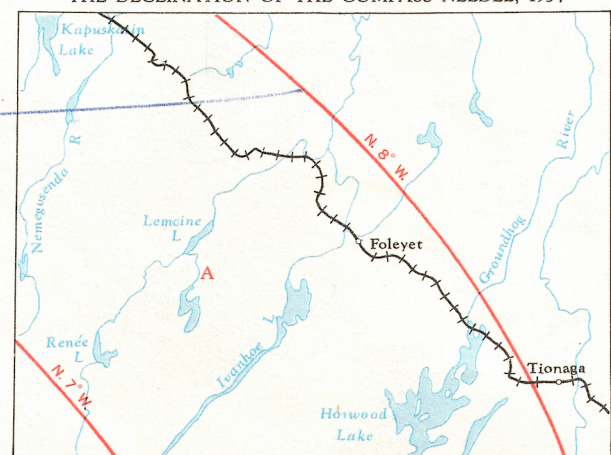

THE DECLINATION OF THE COMPASS NEEDLE, 1954



The declination of the compass needle at any place along a red line is the declination given on that red line. At other places the declination is between those given on the neighbouring red lines than at the place named. At the declination is between N. 7° W. and N. 8° W. The quarterly declination of the compass needle are decreasing 3 minutes annually.

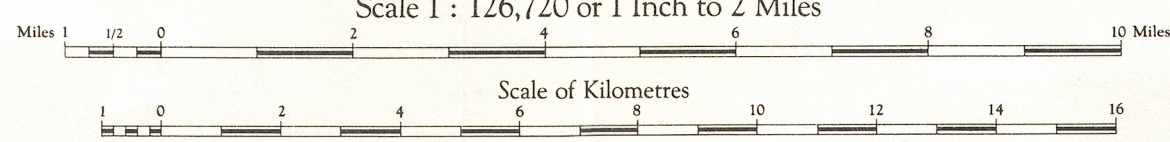

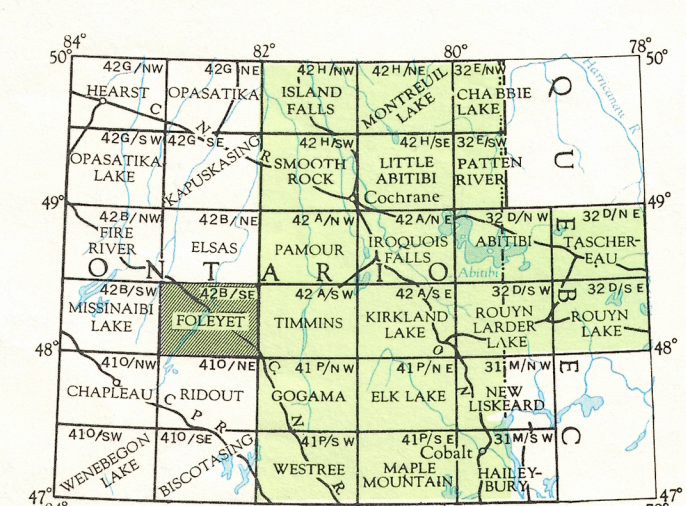
