GRID ZONE DESIGNATION 13 U

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (as above)

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line outward to point.

NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.

EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 975984

Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
