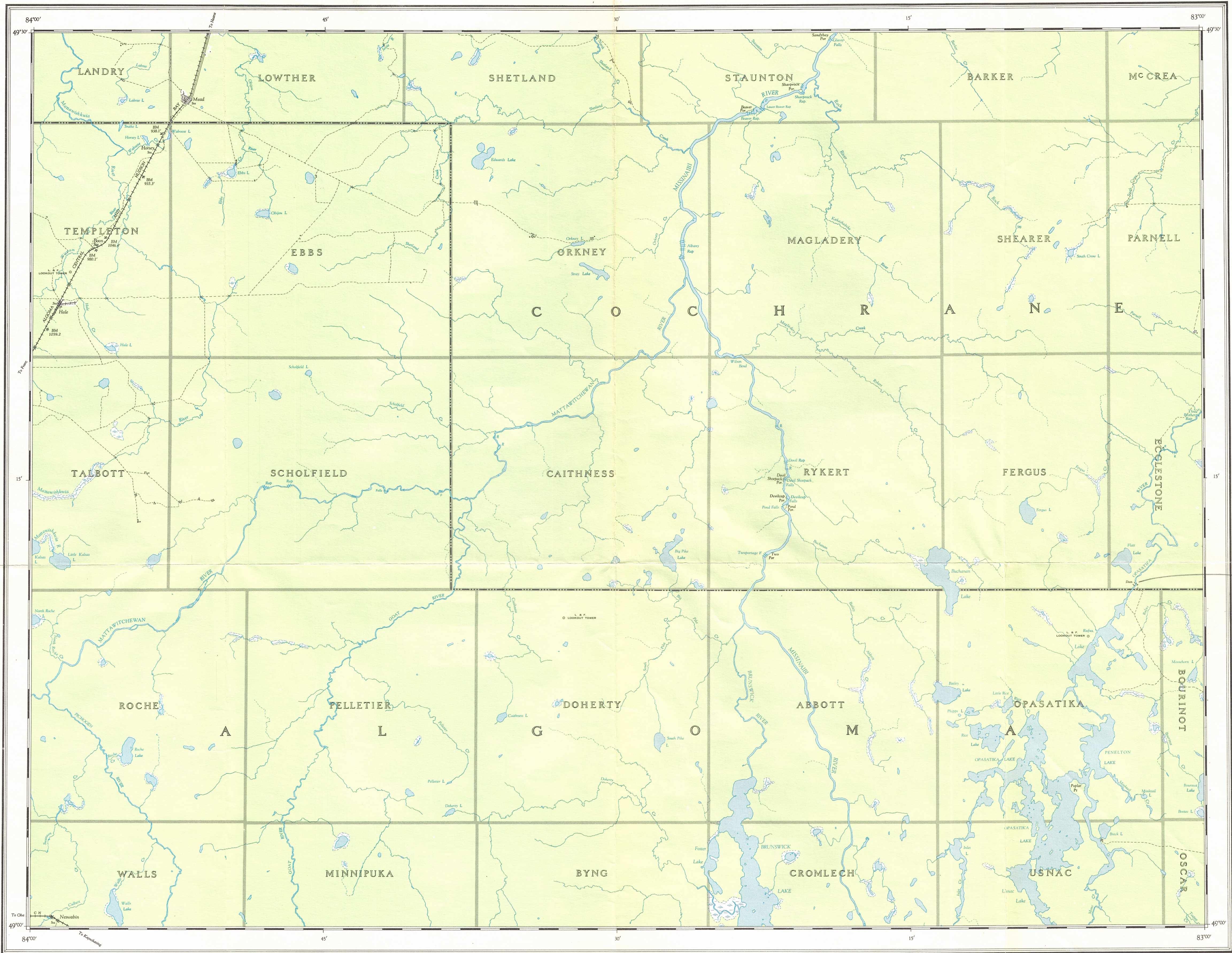


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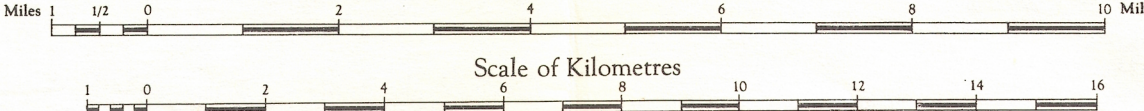
The magnetic declination at the centre of this sheet is calculated to be  $N 80^{\circ} 11' 30''$  in June 1955.  
The westerly declination of the compass needle is decreasing 3 minutes annually.

On future editions of this map, Planimetric adjustments will be made as additional horizontal control becomes available.

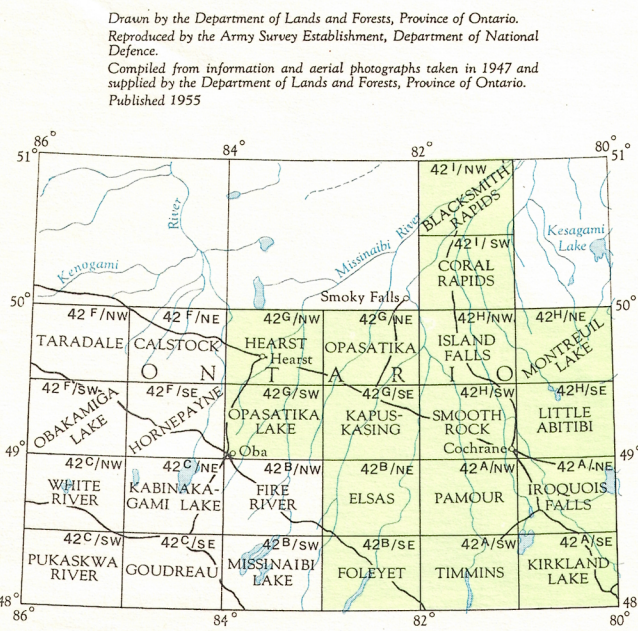
