TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 1,000 METRES

EXAMPLE: STREAM JUNCTION

SQUARE: Read letters of 100,000 m. square

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point

NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point

MILITARY GRID REFERENCE (to nearest 1,000 metres): MA6372

If reporting beyond 18° in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation as: 20VMA6372

THE DECLINATION OF THE COMPASS NEEDLE 1959

The declination of the compass needle at any place along a broken line is the declination given on that broken line. At other places the declination is between those given on the neighbouring broken lines; thus at the place marked A, the declination is between 39°30'W and 40°00'W. The declination of the compass needle is decreasing 0.5 minutes annually.
