

GRID ZONE DESIGNATION: 10V DD ED DC EC 50 680
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 1000 METRES
EXAMPLE: HORIZONTAL CONTROL POINT
SQUARE: Read letters of 100,000 m. square DD
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point
MILITARY GRID REFERENCE (to nearest 1,000 metres): DD7923


