In regard to your request for information regarding the derivation of the name "Rolling River" would say that as far as we know the name has been derived from the natural feature of the river itself. It is a very turbulent, bristorous, swift running stream which flows over a very rough stony bed. Thus a loud rolling noise may be heard for miles around. This

is especially noticed in the
 springs of the year when the
 river is high. Thus the settle-
 ment or district around the
 stream has been called direct-
 ly after it - "Rolling River". As to
 who named the settlement - no
 definite information is known
 can be obtained.
