The village Cranton Section derived its name from the first Post Office being kept by a person of that name and a number of families surrounding the Post Office being of that name, it is situated on the Margaree River surrounded by high Mountains the Mountains having no special name.

The oldest resident - died in August - last - 1905 being 95 years old Mr Stephen Phillips he came to or rather was born when this valley was just - in its infancy. It is now a beautiful place the river abounds in Salmon and trout and is a great resort - for American sports men.
