The Postmaster handed me  
 this communication. In reply Harrow  
was named by John A Connor then  
member of Parliament afterwards  
Post Master General, after a place in  
England, at the request of my Father  
 who founded the office carried the mail  
 for four years to Oxford now called  
 Osley on the Lake Erie. Now my  
 Father Joseph Munger kept the Office  
 for until his death in 1863 cannot  
 tell you the year but suppose about  
 1850 or a little later my Father  
 thus founded the Town. I am still on  
 the old home am selling the Town  
 paper to build on
