lived here 14 years. This village never had any  
other name. The business done here is Lumbering  
and Farming in the village there is 2 Stores 2 Saw  
mills 1 Blacksmith 1 Pump Factory 1 Shingle Mill  
2 Planing Mills 1 Church 1 School 1 Town Hall  
& other Mills close to the Village Oliver Lake 5  
miles South of us White Fish 2 9 miles ~~West~~ South  
West Geo Lake 8 miles West Kakabaca Falls  
9 miles N. East Post Master Hymers
