In reply to your inquiry as to how this place was named "Renwick" would state. When the L.E. & N. Railway was built through here, about eleven years ago, the company called this station Renwick after Mr J. C. Renwick. The P.O. which started soon afterwards was also called Renwick

Mr Thomas Coke Renwick was born on the farm where he is now on the Lake Shore road where he still resides. He is now in his eighty-second year and is still quite smart and active and holds the office of secretary of Kent's & Essex fire insurance co and although there is a great deal of work in connection therewith he does it all without assistance. I might state also that he has been superintendent of the Methodist Sabbath school continuously for over fifty years
