Dear Sir:-

A short time ago I received a letter from you requesting information respecting the name "Ronson P. O." This is simply a country post-office with very few people receiving mail here. About thirty or forty years ago it was a thriving little village named Rolph after Dr Rolph a leader of the Reform party of 1824. Then some other place took the same name and the name was changed to Ronson because there were a number of families having that name, in the vicinity. I don't think there was any particular person whom it was named after. There are only ~~two~~ persons receiving mail here now, of that name. They are, Mr George Ronson, and Mr Ira Ronson. This, I think contains all the particulars you asked for.
