Dear Sir

in reference to the geographcal of
this place as an old settler I will endeavor to give you
what I know in the first place Coopers falls derives its
name from Mr Tho's Cooper an old settler of some 35 or 40
years he as follow general merchant & farming the Black River
run throught our settlement the river run her about N.E. & S.W.
N.E. from here is the big eddie shoot called because of a bayanda eddie
at the foot 1 mile $\frac{1}{2}$ down stream is situated Coopers falls 2 miles
below is the flat Rapids ~~deriving~~ it name from being
a long flat Rappids about a mile $\frac{1}{2}$ North is Clear water
Lake so called because the other water are all black the lake
is very spring North of Clear water Lake is spruce Lake being
call so because of a growth spruce 3 miles further North is the
Cosh see ~~the~~ bog a bog lake to the east of Clear water Lake
is mud Lake get it name from being marsh and boggy all
around it in places around Clear water Lake there are indications
of mica in place on the surface but people say it no good there is
a big Mountain East of Clear water called Rattans look out he
is a Hunter and he watch for deer there yours &c
