Beach Point is the name of a sand beach at the mouth of Murray Harbor. A shipbuilding and fish-curing industry and also a mercantile business was carried on on it and the post office was first started there and thus gets its name.

The Office is now located in the centre of the District. The District forms the Southeastern point of the Island and is named Cape Bear so called from being at one time a resort of bears or from a rock standing a short distance out into the water supposed to resemble a bear. It was of sandstone and has lately fallen down. There is a rock further from the shore called the seal rock. There is another beach on the north side of the mouth of the Harbor which we call Poverty Beach.
