

Pointe Bleue

My Postmaster's slip is only for The Hudson Reserve, and there is no other Bays or points except "Pointe Bleue" at the extreme point of which is built the Stores & Dwellings of the Hudsons Bay Co.

The only explanation of the name, so far as I have heard or can find out, is, that in the early days, when all the goods coming here in Summer had to come up the Saguenay ~~and were~~ as far as Quevontine and then through the Falls & Rivers till they reached Lake St John at St Gideon a distance from Pt Bleue of about 20 miles. When the Voyagers arrived there if the weather was at all fine, this point seemed always to loom up, with a distinct blue color. Hence the name.
