In reply to your query regarding the origin of the above name, I have much pleasure in informing you that it is the name of a Cree Chief who used to hunt in this neighbourhood a few years ago & who died, I believe, two years ago. A bluff on 2. 34. 5 was named 'White Hawk Bluff' by Seymour de J. Cunningham, one of the first (rancher) settlers here, about the year ago in commemoration of a remarkable exhibition of woodcraft given by White Hawk while stalking a wounded elk.
